

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: HUMANISM AND DEMOCRACY AMERICAN INSTITUTE, INC. and the initial principal address of the corporation is: 3081 N.W. 6 Street, Miami, Florida 33125

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of this corporation is PERPETUAL unless dissolved according the law. Corporate existence shall commence upon filling with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To help to promote the integral development of those sectors of population economically less favored in both the United States and other countries;
2. To improve the levels of organization of those sectors of population economically less favored in order to work efficiently to resolve their problems;
3. To design and support economic, social, educational and cultural programs and projects, specially those able to generate employment, better incomes and improve the levels of education, techniques and culture of the sectors of population economically less favored;
4. To support the young population in its efforts of self-improvement and education;
5. To support women and their families before the different problems that affect their integral development;
6. To help to make possible that those sectors of population living in the United States with immigrations problems can be able to obtain an immigration status that help them to stabilize themselves and live a more productive and happy life;
7. To promote the american citizenship between permanent residents and to vote in the different types elections participating in the solution of every kind of problems;
8. To coordinate programs, projects and activities with other organizations working in the immigration, civic and development areas;
9. To realize congresses, seminars, courses, encounters, circles of studies and other educational and cultural events that help those people to conserve and cultivate the positive parte of their cultural roots and to contribute positively to the society where they live;
10. To inform to the american people about the reality of those sectors of population economically less favored in both , the United States and other countries;
11. To publish books, pamphlets, magazines, bulletins, newspapers and articles about the reality of those sectors of population economically less favored in both the United States and other countries;
12. To make social researches, technical studies, development programs and projects and provide economic, technical and human support to those kind of activities;
13. To provide services to those sectors economically less favored, both in the United States and other countries;
14. To help those groups of citizens who work for the integral development and democracy in the different countries of the American Continent;
15. Other objectives according the nature of the Institute.

ARTICLES IV

The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission are:

- 1) To have a title in any discipline of the social sciences or similar studies or have experiences and/or activities of social activism;
- 2) To pay an initial admission-fee determined by the Board of Directors.
- 3) To be accepted by the Board of Directors of the Institute or by the Admission Committee that this organism decides.
- 4) All and every member will pay a monthly cuote determined by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V

The street address and city of the initial registered office of the corporation is:

ARTICLE VI

The number of members constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is five, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are:

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors, consisting of not less than three (3) persons. The numbers of directors may be until seven (7), provided however that such numbers may be changed by a By-Law duly adopted by the members. Directors elected at the first annual meeting and at all times thereafter, shall serve for a term of two (2) years until the bi-annual meeting of members following the election of Directors and until the qualifications of the successors in office.

Annual meetings shall be held on or about the first day of September of each year at the place as the Board of Directors may designate from time to time by resolution. Any other disposition about this matter will be exercised according to stated in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII

This corporation is organized under a non-stock basis.

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive purpose of social assistance.





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
