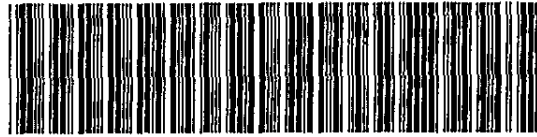

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Menu King State Scholarship Fund, Inc. will promote and grow its scholarship program by working with a number of related organizations such as, but not limited to, D.E.C.A., Future Business Leaders of America, Youth Sport Leagues. We will grow through the Charitable Donations made by Corporations and the Public. The purpose is to provide the Students, Youth Leagues, and Educational Organizations in Florida additional resources through Charitable Contributions made by the Public and Corporations.

In all of its activities Menu King will comply with the following guidelines:

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal tax codes.

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for non-profit purposes, and no part of any net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, or officer.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501 (c) (3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV: TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION

The affairs of this corporation are to be managed by the following officers: President, Vice President (3), Secretary, Treasurer, and a Board of Directors consisting of the above officers and such other directors as may be provided in the ByLaws. The officers and directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the corporation, as provided in the ByLaws, to hold office until the end of the succeeding annual meeting.
