

Articles of Incorporation Of Joanne's Hospitality House, Inc. A Non Profit Corporation

Pursuant to the provision of the Nonprofit Corporation Act 617. of the State of Florida, the undersigned incorporators hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I Corporate Name

The name of this corporation shall is Joanne's Hospitality House, Inc.

Article II Registered Agent Name & Address

Article III Corporation Purposes

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to provide education and charitable assistance which may include but not be limited to housing, employment services, basic and vocational education, anger management, drug abuse prevention and family reconciliation to clients who are newly released from prison.

This program is intended to facilitate the re-entry and/or the phasing of the clients into the community by providing them with a full service program hosted in a positive environment.

This corporation is organized exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of 501 (c) (3) of the internal revenue code.

This corporation will engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the General Corporation Law of Florida provided, however, that the corporation shall only engage in acts or activities that are consistent with and in furtherance of its 501 (c) (3) tax exempt purposes.

Article IV Manner of Election

this corporation makes no provision for members.

The initial Board of Directors is appointed by the incorporator and will serve a staggered term of one (1) year, two (2) years and three (3) years respectively. Thereafter, at the annual meeting, to be held on or about the second Tuesday of August, a Director will be elected for a three (3) year term to fill each vacant seat.

Article VIII Prohibitions

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to educational and charitable purposes. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501 (h) of the Internal Revenue Code) and this corporation shall not Participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members, directors or other private persons except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not to be carried on by: 1) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or 2) a corporation to which contributions are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
