ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, for the purposes of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for profit Corporation Act, here by adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: The Tallahassee Fellowship of the Anglican Mission in America, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is:

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ARTICLE III DURATION

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, commencing with the filing of these Articles with the Department of State of the State of Florida. In the event of dissolution the residual assets of the Corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the federal, state or local government for exclusively public purposes.

ARTICLE IV PURPOSES

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable in nature and are:

- To proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ focusing on Tallahassee and surrounding areas.
- To nurture a movement of small groups of Believers in Tallahassee and surrounding areas.
- To provide support to the Christian community in Tallahassee and surrounding areas.
- 4. To raise funds to provide financial and material support for those in the movement according to their need.

The corporation shall not, as its primary activity, engage in a regular business of a kind which ordinarily carries on for profit. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, educational and charitable within the meaning of section 501C(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE V DEDICATION OF ASSETS

All of the funds and other property of this corporation and any monies or other benefits from its operations shall be used solely for the religious, educational and charitable projects in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation. No dividends shall be paid and no part of the income or other funds of the corporation of any kind shall be used for the individual benefit of shareholders, directors, officers, employees or any other persons except as reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation in carrying out one or more of its purposes or as reimbursement for expenses incurred in connection therewith. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of the articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activity or activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code), or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future Code).

ARTICLE VI MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

(a) <u>Board of Directors</u>: The power of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a board of directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall be four (4); provided, however, that such number may be changed by the addition of directors by unanimous action of the directors. The board of directors shall consist of such persons as may be chosen from time to time by a majority of the members. Each director shall serve until his successor is named by the board of directors. The initial directors of the corporation shall be appointed by the undersigned incorporator.

(b) <u>Corporate Officers</u>: The board of directors shall elect such officers as the bylaws of this corporation may authorize the directors to elect from time to time. Such officers shall be initially elected at the organizational meeting of the board of directors.
