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



The place in this state where the principal office of the Organization is to be located is 20 Stevens Drive, Midway, Florida 32343, Gadsden County Florida.



This organization is organized exclusively for religious purposes. Leading Edge Impact, Inc. will carry out its mission by conducting leadership conferences, seminar training, and other speaking engagements including, but not limited to speaking at churches. Leading Edge Impact Inc. will utilize other methods of communication to foster its mission, including but not limited to the publication of books, articles and by maintaining a website with inspiration and instructional materials. Leading Edge Impact, Inc. is not an organization that solicits others to become members. Leading Edge Impact, Inc. is supported by contributions from the general public.

ARTICLE IV

The names and address of the persons who are the initial officers of the corporation are as follows:

Officers will be appointed by the Director as the needs of the corporation dictate additional officers. The corporation will conduct quarterly meetings to schedule and plan events and to ensure that the mission of the corporation is carried out successfully. Once three or more officers have been appointed, items on the agenda at quarterly meetings will be decided by voting, with each officer having one vote. The agenda will be set by the Director. The Executive Assistant will handle the daily operation of the corporation at the discretion of the Director.

As the income of the corporation permits, the Director and Officers of the corporation will be paid for their services.

The method of election of the Director of the corporation is as stated in the bylaws of the corporation.


ARTICLE V


No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) for any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. This organization shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purpose of this organization.

ARTICLE VI

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed to an organization or church for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.


