

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

STAR – LITE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORP.

The undersigned, acting as incorporation of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

STAR - LITE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORP.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and mailing address shall be:

ARTICLE III <u>PURPOSES</u>

- 1. Specific purpose of the corporation will be to engage in the community development projects designed to improve the quality of life of the economically, socially disenfranchised elderly persons.
- 2. The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively

charitable and educational within the meaning of section n 501 (c) of the Internal revenue Code of 1986 or any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law

- 3. To serve as a local, state and national liaison for the frail in need of economic, social or any alternative form on assistance.
- 4. To plan organize and sponsor leisure activities for the benefit of the elderly.
- 5. To formulate development and build affordable housing for the frail elderly population.
- 6. To engage in any other legal business necessary to the achievement corporate goals and objectives. .

ARTICLE IV DISSOLUTION CLAUSE

Upon dissolution of the corporation either as an act of law or by resolution of the Board of Directors assets of the corporation will be distributed to a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation. "However" if the named recipient is not in existence or is no longer qualified as a distributee, or unwilling to accept the distribution, the assets of the organization shall be distributed to a fund, foundation, or organization which is organized and operated exclusively for purposes specified in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE V <u>LIMITATION OF POWERS</u>

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt form federal income tax under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any correspondence provision of any United States Internal Law.
