The undersigned, by these Articles associate themselves for the purpose of forming corporation not for profit under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and certify as follows:

ARTICLE I. NAME

ARTICLE IX. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

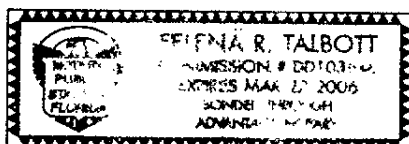
This corporation shall have three directors initially. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by the by-laws. The names and addresses of the initial directors of this corporation are:
