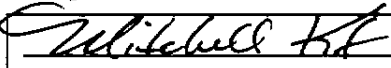
The Corporation's powers are as follows:

ARTICLE X

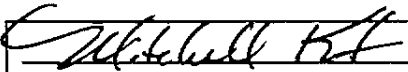
