We, the undersigned of Mango, Florida, hereby associate ourselves and our successors into a corporation not for profit under the corporate name of THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, Mango, Florida, and hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, and it is located at Mango, Hillsborough County, Florida.

ARTICLE II

The general nature and object of this corporation is to buy, purchase, own, acquire, by gift, devise, purchase or otherwise, real and personal property, and to build, erect, construct, provide for, maintain and equip suitable buildings, churches, houses, etc. for the benefit, use and occupation of THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, Mango, Florida, its members and congregation, in maintaining and fostering public worship, and the preaching and teaching of the Word of God and the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and for all other meetings and purposes of the said THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, its members and congregation. To build, construct, erect, maintain and equip Sunday schools, mission stations and mission churches, pastors' homes and such other houses or equipment as the said Church may desire for carrying on this work.

To receive, administer, disburse and invest gifts, devises and bequests by or from any persons or corporations.

To issue bonds, notes, debentures and evidences of indebtedness and to secure the same by mortgage, deed of trust or otherwise.

This corporation is organized primarily for the purpose of holding the title to such property or properties as the said THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, Mango, Florida, shall, from time to time, purchase or acquire, and it shall have power, from time to time, to make such contracts and to do such things as shall be authorized by the members of the said THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, Mango, Florida.

ARTICLE III

Any member of THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, Mango, Florida, shall be held and considered a member of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The names and residences of the subscribers are as follows:

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees, subject to the approval of the local Church, of not less than three nor more than nine, and who shall be elected from among the members of THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO at the annual meeting of the Church, or at a special meeting duly called for that purpose, to serve until the next Church year and until their successors have been

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elected and qualified. The Board of Trustees shall elect from its membership a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

All deeds, conveyances, notes or mortgages pertaining to the real estate of the corporation shall be executed under the seal of the corporation and shall be signed by the President of the Board of Trustees and Attested by the Secretary of said Board, but no real estate owned by the corporation shall be sold, mortgaged or disposed of by the Trustees without the matter of the proposed sale or mortgage being submitted to, and approved by, a majority vote of the members present at the annual meeting, or at a special meeting, of THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, Mango, Florida, duly called for that purpose.

ARTICLE VII

The names of the officers of the Board of Trustees who are to manage the affairs of the corporation until their successors are elected and qualified shall be as follows:

Secretary	B. F. Osteen
Treasurer	E. W. Harrison

ARTICLE VIII

The By-Laws of this corporation shall be made, altered or rescinded by the members of THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MANGO, Mango, Florida, at the annual meeting of the Church, or at a special meeting duly called for that purpose; but any amendment or alteration of said By-Laws shall only be made by a two-thirds vote of the members present at such meeting.

ARTICLE IX

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which this corporation may, at any time, subject itself shall be the sum of Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dollars, provided any such sum or indebtedness shall not exceed two-thirds in value of the total gross value of the property of the corporation.

This corporation shall have power to bond or mortgage its property in a sum not exceeding Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of carrying into effect the objects of its incorporation as set forth in this charter, or for any portion or part thereof.

ARTICLE X

This corporation may hold real estate in the value of One Million (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars, subject always to the approval of the Circuit Judge.

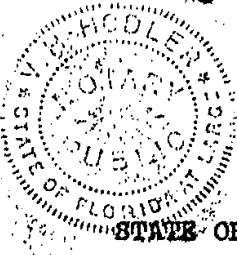

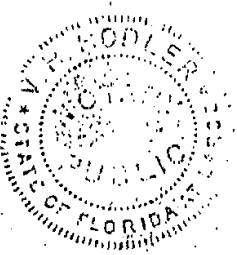
