ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit) OF Environmental Bioindicators Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: ENVIRONMENTAL BIOINDICATORS FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE
