ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CREATING A STRONG FOUNDATION FOR FAMILIES, INC. (Not for Profit)

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05 NOV 18 AM 5 We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together the purpose of becoming a corporation not for profit under Chapter 617, laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liability, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Creating a Strong Foundation for Families, Inc. This not for profit corporation is organized for the purpose of strengthening families through Christian principles of love, kindness and compassion. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purpose, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE II

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Second hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
