

#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

#### WESTON CHAMBER ORCHESTRA FOUNDATION, INC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of incorporation.

#### Article I

#### NAME

The name of the comporation is: WESTON CHAMBER ORCHESTRA FOUNDATION, INC address shall be:2900 Glades cir. Suite 1650 , Weston, Florida 33327.

#### Article II

#### **DURATION**

The Corporation shall exist perpetually. Corporate existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.

#### Article III

#### **NATURE OF BUSINESS**

The corporation is organized exclusively for cultural and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. In this connection, its principal purpose shall be to foster the public performance of orchestral music, primarily in Weston, Florida and its environs, by undertaking activities that shall be limited to, one or more of the following:

- Organizing and operating a classical orchestra by the name of Weston
   Chamber Orchestm and/or related musical groups; with its base of
   operation in Weston, Florida.
- Fromoting and producing, and causing or helping to be promoted and produced, musical concerts, productions and entenzimments, of and by Weston Chamber Orchestra and/or related ensembles or which otherwise benefit the organization or operation of the classical orchestra.
- Fostering interest in orchestral, instrumental, choral and vocal music and the development of instrumental and vocal musicians.

 Organizing, supporting, taking part in and assisting activities having these ends in view or incidental to these purposes.

In furtherance of these purposes, the corporation shall have all powers specified in the Nonprofit Corporation Act and may exercise such powers except as limited fin the articles of incorporation as they now exist or may be amended in the future, by the bylaws to be adopted or as they may be attended in the future, or by any laws governing the activities of the corporation.
