# NON-PROFIT ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Distinguish Sports, Inc.

A Non Profit Corporation with No Members

The undersigned incorporator does hereby make, file and acknowledge these Non Profit Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporate Act, and hereby adapt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation and state the following.

### ARTICLE I NAME OF THE CORPORATION Distinguish Sports, Inc. The name of this corporation shall be: **ARTICLE II**

PURPOSE(S) THE NATURE OF BUSINESS

The purpose(s) for which this corporation is formed and organized are: This is a non-stock non-profit corporation. This corporation will engage in, but shall not be limited to the following activities: The establishment of a competitive athletic program that empowers, educates, and showcases underprivileged atrisk youth by implementing a drug, crime and violence prevention program that promotes social habilitation, cultural diversity and enrichment which shall be disseminated through Tournament events, athletic competitions and the making and distribution of literature to organizations for dissemination, education, fundraising, sponsorship, donating and making contributions, as well as buying, selling, leasing and /or transferring real estate property as charitable and philanthropic organizations.

Said corporation is established under section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code of any future United States Review law, Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by any organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. (put this paragraph in bylaws Art.2)

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on, (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income Tax under section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C) 2 of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future tax code).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or any private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered an to make payments and distribution in furtherance of Section 501 (C) 3 purposed. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

The four ways this purpose will be accomplished are:

- Provide Athletic Sports Tournament Competitions, Events as well as academic educational support training.
- The presentation of supportive athletic and recreation services that are drug, crime, and violence intervention . 2.
- 3, The publication and distribution of literature concerning competitive sports events, substance abuse, crime and violence Prevention and sexual awareness of STD (sexual transmitted diseases).
- The recruitment, hiring and training of staff, volunteers, interns and apprentices who will assist in facilitating the day to 4. day operational duties as well as behavioral assistance, transportation, event planning, design and implementation.
