



OF
SHILOH BIBLE CHURCH, DUNEDIN, FL

Article 1.

Purposes, Objectives and Governing Instruments

Section 1.01 Charitable, Educational, and Scientific Purposes and Powers. The purposes of Shiloh Bible Church, as set forth in the Articles of Incorporation, are charitable, educational, and/or religious, as a provision of any future Federal tax law. In furtherance of such purposes, Shiloh Bible Church shall have the same powers as an individual to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out the purposes, as set forth in the Articles of Incorporation and these Bylaws. The specific purposes of Shiloh Bible Church are to operate a non-profit, non-denominational Christ-centered spiritual community.

Section 1.02 Governing Instruments. Shiloh Bible Church shall be governed and operated according to the Bible (the Word and Will of Jesus Christ, its principles, practices, and procedures especially as described for the Church in the New Testament), Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws.

Section 1.03 Nondiscrimination Policy. Shiloh Bible Church will not practice or permit any unlawful discrimination on the basis of sex, age, race, color, national origin, religion, physical handicap or disability, or any other basis prohibited by law.

Article 2. Membership

Shiloh Bible Church members acknowledge Romans 10:9 - That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. The Church principles, practices, and procedures are to be carried out by members of the Church serving in offices such as: Pastor, Deacons, Teachers, evangelists, administrators, ministers, and the Helps. 1 Cor 12:28

Article 3. Directors

Section 3.01 Annual Meeting. A meeting of the Board shall be held annually at such place, on such date and at such time as may be fixed by the Board, for the purpose of electing Directors, receiving annual reports of the Board and Officers, and for the transaction of such other business as may be brought before the meeting. Transaction of such other business as may be brought before the meeting.

Section 3.02 Number. The number of Directors constituting the entire Board shall be fixed by the Board, but

Section 3.03 Election and Term of Office. The initial Directors of Shiloh Bible Church shall be those persons specified in the Articles of Incorporation of Shiloh Bible Church. Each Director shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the Board and until such Director's successor has been elected and qualified, or until his or her death, resignation or removal.

The selection of candidates for office is to be carried out by the Church membership and appointed to serve as needed by the Pastor, . Acts 6:1-7

Acts 6 And, in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplied, there arose murmuring of the Grecians against the Hebrews, because their widows were neglected in the daily ministration.

2 Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples unto them, and said, It is not reason That we should leave the word of God, and serve tables.

3 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

4 But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word.

5 And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch:

Section 3.04 Powers and Duties. Subject to the provisions of law, of the Articles of Incorporation and of these By-Laws, but in furtherance and not in limitation of any rights and powers thereby conferred, the Board shall have the control and management of the affairs and operations of Shiloh Bible Church and shall exercise all the powers that may be exercised by Shiloh Bible Church.

The Deacon's sole duty is at the Pastor's direction, to assist him (Pastor) in carrying out the mission of the Church. The Deacons can be appointed by the Pastor to serve in areas such as, but not limited to; Trustees, Teachers, Leaders, etc., as needed.

Section 3.05 Meetings. Regular meetings of the Board may be held at such times as the Board may from time to time determine. Special meetings of the Board may also be called at any time by the President or by a majority of the Directors then in office.

Section 3.06 Quorum. At any meeting of the Board, a majority of the Directors then in office shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. However, should a quorum not be present, a majority of the Directors present may adjourn the meeting from time to time to another time and

Section 3.07 Voting. At all meetings of the Board, each Director shall have one vote. In the event that there is a tie in any vote, the President shall have an additional vote to be the tie-breaker.

Section 3.08 Action Without a Meeting. Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board or any committee thereof may be taken without a meeting if all members of the Board or any such committee consent in writing to the adoption of a resolution authorizing the action. The resolution and the written consents thereto by the members of the Board or any such committee shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the Board or such committee.

Section 3.09 Removal. Any Director may be removed for cause by vote of the Board provided there is a quorum of not less than a majority present at the meeting at which such action is taken.

Section 3.10 Resignation. Any Director may resign from office at any time by delivering a resignation in writing to the Board of Directors, and the acceptance of the resignation, unless required by its terms, shall not be necessary to make the resignation effective.

Section 3.11 Committee. The Board, by resolution adopted by a majority of the entire Board, may designate from among the Directors an executive committee and other standing committees, each consisting of three or more Directors, to serve at the pleasure of the Board, and each of which, to the extent provided in such resolution, shall have the authority of the Board. The Board may designate one or more Directors as alternate members of any such committee, who may replace any absent member or members at any meeting of such committee.

Section 3.12 Participation by Telephone. Any one or more members of the Board or any committee thereof may participate in a meeting of the Board or such committee by means of a conference telephone or similar communications equipment allowing all persons participating in the meeting to hear each other at the same time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at a meeting.

Article 4. Officers

Section 4.01 Election and Qualifications; Term of Office. The Officers of Shiloh Bible Church shall be a President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. The Officers shall be elected by the Board at the annual meeting of the Board and each Officer shall hold office for a term of one year and until such Officer's successor has been elected or appointed and qualified, unless such Officer shall have resigned or shall have been removed. The same person may hold more than one office, except that the same person may not be both President and Secretary. The Board may appoint such other Officers as may be deemed desirable, including one or more Vice-Presidents, one or more Assistant Secretaries, and one or more Assistant Treasurers. Such Officers shall serve for such period as the Board may designate.

Section 4.02 Vacancies. Any vacancy occurring in any office, whether because of death, resignation or removal, with or without cause, or any other reason, shall be filled by the Board.

Section 4.03 Powers and Duties of the President. The President shall from time to time make such reports of the affairs and operations of Shiloh Bible Church as the Board may direct and shall preside at all meetings of the Board. The President shall have such other powers and shall perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned to the President by the Board.

Section 4.04 Powers and Duties of the Vice-Presidents. Each of the Vice-Presidents, if any, shall have such powers and shall perform such duties as may from time to time be assigned to such Vice President by the Board.

Section 4.05 Powers and Duties of the Secretary. The Secretary shall record and keep the minutes of all meetings of the Board. The Secretary shall be the custodian of and shall make or cause to be made the proper entries in, the minute book of Shiloh Bible Church and such books and records as the Board may direct. The Secretary shall have such other powers and shall perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned to the Secretary by the Board.

Section 4.06 Powers and Duties of the Treasurer. The Treasurer shall be the custodian of all funds and securities of Shiloh Bible Church. Whenever so directed by the Board, the Treasurer shall render a statement of the cash and other accounts of Shiloh Bible Church, and the Treasurer shall cause to be entered regularly in the books and records of Shiloh Bible Church to be kept for such purpose full and accurate accounts of Shiloh Bible

the books and accounts to any Director upon application at the principal office of Shiloh Bible Church during business hours. The Treasurer shall have such other powers and shall perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned to the Treasurer by the Board.

Section 4.07 Delegation. In case of the absence of any Officer of Shiloh Bible Church, or for any other reason that the Board may deem sufficient, the Board may at any time and from time to time delegate all or any part of the powers or duties of any Officer to any other Officer or to any Director or Directors.

Section 4.08 Removal. Any Officer may be removed from office at any time, with or without cause, by a vote of a majority of the Directors then in office at any meeting of the Board.

Section 4.09 Resignation. Any Officer may resign his or her office at any time, such resignation to be made in writing and to take effect immediately without acceptance by Shiloh Bible Church.

Article 5.

Bank Accounts, Checks, Contracts and Investments

Section 5.01 Bank Accounts, Checks and Notes. The Board is authorized to select the banks or depositories it deems proper for the funds of Shiloh Bible Church. The Board shall determine who shall be authorized from time to time on Shiloh Bible Church's behalf to sign checks, drafts, or other orders for the payment of money, acceptances, notes or other evidence of indebtedness.

Section 5.02 Contracts. The Board may authorize any Officer or Officers, agent or agents, in addition to those specified in these By-Laws, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances. Unless so authorized by the Board, no Officer, agent or employee shall have any power or authority to bind

liable for any purpose or to any amount.

Section 5.03 Investments. The funds of Shiloh Bible Church may be retained in whole or in part in cash or be invested and reinvested from time to time in such property, real, personal or otherwise, or stocks, bonds or other securities, as the Board may deem desirable.

Article 6.

Dissolution

The Corporation may be dissolved only upon adoption of a plan of dissolution and distribution of assets by the Board that is consistent with the Articles of Incorporation and with Florida State law.

Article 7.

Amendments These By-Laws may be altered, amended, added to or repealed at any meeting of the Board called for that purpose by the vote of a majority of the Directors then in office.




