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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CRANDON MARINA YACHT CLUB, INC.

<u>ARTICLE I</u>

NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be:

CRANDON MARINA YACHT CLUB, INC.

The address of the principal office and the initial street address, in this state, of this Corporation is: 8370 W. Flagler St., Suite #248, Miami, FL 33144.

<u>ARTICLE II</u>

CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

CORPORATE PURPOSES

The Corporation shall be a nonprofit, nonsectarian organization formed and operated exclusively for exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code, which purposes shall include, but not be limited to, the promotion of members social events, gatherings, boat trips and any other type of activity contributing to the members interests and welfare.

The Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax pursuant to section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue code. No part of the assets or the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any officer, director, member, or any other person. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be dedicated to attempting to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise. The Corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign for or on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Unless otherwise indicated, as used in this Article III and hereinafter in these Articles of Incorporation, all section references are to the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, including any corresponding provision of any subsequently enacted federal tax laws.

ARTICLE IV

CORPORATE POWERS

The Corporation shall have and exercise all powers accorded corporations not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida which are not in conflict with the Corporation's exempt purposes as provided in Article III.

ARTICLE V

CAPITAL STOCK

The Corporation shall not have capital stock.

ARTICLE VI

MEMBERS

The qualification for members and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the Bylaws of the Corporation, which may establish different classes of membership and may limit any voting rights to one or more of such classes.

ARTICLE VII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The powers of the Corporation shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of, a Board of Directors, the number of which may be either increased or decreased from time to time as regulated by the Bylaws but shall consist of not fewer than tree directors. Where not inconsistent with Chapters 607 and 617, Florida Statutes, and the express provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the Board of Directors shall have all the rights, powers, and privileges prescribed by law of directors of corporations for profit.

DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution, all of the Corporation's assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed for an exempt purpose to any organization which shall then be qualified for exemption under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and to which a contribution shall be permitted as a deduction under sections 170, 2055, or 2522 of the Internal Revenue Code, as applicable, or to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. None of the assets shall be distributed to any officer, director, or member of the Corporation, or any other person or organization not described in the preceding sentence.

ARTICLE IX

AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by majority vote of the voting members of the Corporation in accordance with the procedures provided by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. Such action may be taken by the voting members present at any regular or special meeting provided proper notice of the changes to be made has been given and a quorum is present, or by the voting members without a meeting if a consent in writing, signed by the voting members whose votes would be necessary to authorize such amendment at a meeting, is filed in the minutes of the Corporation. Within ten days after obtaining such authorization by written consent, notice summarizing the action shall be given to those members who have not consented in writing.
