ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SPACE COAST VIPER BASEBALL/SOFTBALL BOOSTER CLUB, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME / REGISTERED OFFICE

Name of the corporation shall be: Space Coast Viper Baseball/Softball Booster Club, Inc. The principal place of business for this corporation shall be:

Space Coast Jr/Sr High School 6150 Banyan St. Cocoa, FL 32927

The mailing address of this corporation shall be:

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that also qualify as Section 501(c)(3) exempt organizations. To this end, the corporation shall give support to the Varsity and Jr. Varsity Baseball/Softball programs at Space Coast Jr/Sr High School through various forms of fundraising. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes.



ARTICLE IV LIMITATIONS

At all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

- (1) No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
- (2) No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislations, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The election of the Directors shall be by majority vote, as stated in the By-Laws of the corporation.

Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
