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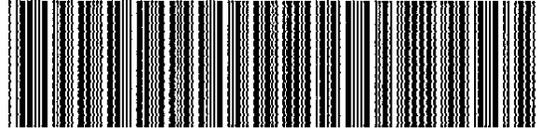

**Articles of Incorporation

*Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of incorporation:*

**Article I: Name of the Corporation**

The name of the corporation shall be: **DOCUMENTS CENTER INC**

**Article II: Principal Office**

The principal place of business and the mailing address of **DOCUMENTS CENTER INC**  
Shall be: 4050 North West 35<sup>th</sup> Way  
Lauderdale Lakes, Florida 33309

**Article III: Purpose**

**DOCUMENTS CENTER INC.** is a multifaceted community education center designed and developed exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(C) (3) Of the Internal Revenue code of 1986, as amended.

1. This Corporation is organized to perform Para-professional work not limited to: completing applications, Incorporations, legal Documents, writing grant proposals, completing income tax returns, responding to evictions, responding to foreclosures, notarizing legal documents, mortgages, leases, notarizing acknowledgements, oaths, consulting, writing curriculum and programs for churches, non-profits, small business and grass-root organizations.
2. Services will include advocacy for the indigent, empowerment classes on resources and networking.
3. This corporation is organized to benefit the Christian and Secular community in and throughout the United States of America, with local and international offices.
4. Documents Center Inc. shall further the provision of health, education, human services, and advocacy for welfare to work, welfare transition, and empowerment to youth, children, young adults, seniors and adults.
5. This corporation will write and develop programs to empower youth to live as responsible community members, and to help in making their communities a safe haven where youth can be educated while developing character, morals and values.
6. This corporation will provide tutoring and educational development, teen and youth leadership, with role modeling by successful executives and women, athletes, politicians, and educators.
7. This corporation is and will be a catalyst for change in communities as it collaborates with other community organizations to bring change and empowerment to communities, business, incorporations, individuals and the Faith Based community.
8. This corporation will help to serve the Faith Based Community with a conglomerate of services on an as needed basis.
9. This corporation will help to establish foundations, trust, and scholarships for noteworthy students, youth, children and adults.

10. This corporation will assist in organizing and structuring new business not limited to childcare centers, day cares, after school care and athletic programs, hands on educational programs as well as consultation to new business and entrepreneurs seeking to establish business using government programs, state programs and funding resources.
11. This corporation will invest in communication endeavors through desktop publishing, advertising, printing and media activities; and all areas of delivering and communicating theories, services, resources and networking arenas.
12. Documents Center Inc. will be a community liaison with educational entities whose endeavors are to promote the development of cognitive and creative skills in the areas of literacy, math, science, music, art and language development.
13. Documents' Center Inc. will be a community liaison with organizations whose mission is to build stronger families while restoring the sanctity of the family through:
  - Development of activities and curriculum that promotes positive self-esteem and self confidence.
  - Development of activities and curriculum that promotes critical thinking skills, independence and self reliance.
  - Development of activities and curriculum that promotes religious beliefs and foundations.
  - Development of social skills and etiquette.
  - Development of activities and curriculum that promotes conflict resolution, self-direction and self-discipline.
  - Promoting communication and literacy skills for children and parents.
  - Development of activities and curriculum promoting cultural sensitivity, cultural diversity and appreciation for cultural arts, heritage and traditions.
14. Documents Center Inc. will network and collaborate with public benefit corporations, organized for a public educational , charitable purpose as recognized under section 501(3) (C) of the Internal Revenue Code.
15. Documents Center Inc. will not discriminate in delivery of services based on race. Creed, Color, Culture, Sexual Orientation, Financial, Economic Class, religious background or beliefs.
16. Documents Center Inc. is organized more specifically, to support and conduct non-partisan research, educational and informational activities to increase public awareness of nonprofit activities.
17. To provide research and information to foundations and corporate giving programs about the needs of organizations that serve or advocate for disadvantaged people.
18. To research the contribution patterns of foundations and corporate giving programs.
19. To sponsor reports, meetings, workshops for non-profit organizations on how to obtain charitable contributions.
20. To conduct research and education about government funding of nonprofit organizations.
21. To sponsor other services to strengthen the stability of the nonprofit sector.
22. To educate the public about funding needs of organizations that provides services or advocacy for disadvantage people.

**Article IV Registered Agent and Registered Office**

**Article V Indemnification and Limitation of Liability:**

1. The Corporation shall indemnify any officer or President or any former officer of the corporation, fully permitted by law. The private property of the member or officer, or president shall not, unless otherwise provided bylaw, be subject to the payment of the corporate debts to any extent whatsoever.
2. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its member, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.
3. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
5. This Corporation shall not discriminate in delivery of services based on race. Creed. Color, Culture, Sexual orientation, Financial or Economic Class or religious background or beliefs.

**Article VI Dissolution and Division of Assets**

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets will be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to other non-profit corporations for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as the court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for non-profit purposes

**Article VII Manner of Election**

*Appointment of Officers:* The President appoints Members of the Board of Directors and determines the number of directors that shall sit on the Board. Vacancies arising due to a terminating event shall remain unfilled until the next annual meeting with duties assumed by other members. Full control of the affairs of the Corporation shall be vested with the President who cannot be elected to office or removed from office.

*Term of Office:* No maximum tenure for any one office on the Board of Directors exists.

*Removal from office:* the President may remove a member of the Board of Directors for just cause.

**Article VIII Membership**

The membership shall represent neighborhood-based agencies, recipient neighborhoods and the community at large. Any charitable, scientific, health and educational agency may become a member as well as students enjoined to the programs provided by the corporation.

**Article IX Officers**

The officers of the Corporation shall consist of the following: Chair of the Board of Directors, Executive Director Secretary, Treasurer and such other officers as the President of the Board of Directors may designate from time to Time.

**Article X Duration of Existence**

The corporation is organized on a non-stock basis and shall be considered established and in existence as of the date of the prepare filing and is specified effective as of ~~January 1, 2006~~ <sup>Feb. 1, 2006</sup>. This corporation shall exist as a perpetual entity unless designated as otherwise by the President of the corporation.

**Article XI Amendments**

The Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the members, partners or officers are subject to this reservation.

**Article XII Bylaws**

This Corporation shall abide by the operating guidelines provided by the bylaws adopted by Documents Center Inc. The Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed by the President/Founder. The Board of Directors may amend or repeal any bylaws as directed by the President /Founder.

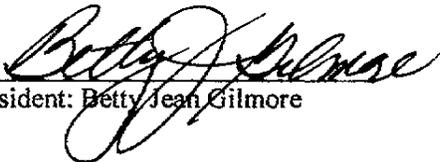

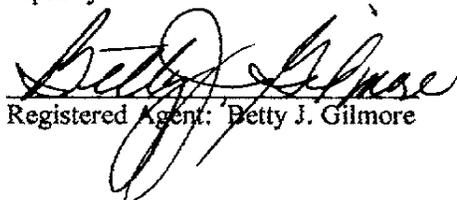
