Articles of Incorporation Of All Purpose Lifeskills, Inc.

The undersigned, desiring to form a not for profit corporation, under the laws of the State of Florida, does hereby states the following:

Article I

The name of the Corporation shall be: All Purpose Lifeskills, Inc.

Article II

The principle place of business and mailing address shall be:

Article III

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- 1) To organize forums with existing agencies and businesses to increase the participants' ability to lead an independent life successfully and/or to make improved lifestyle management decisions, without regard to race, gender, denomination, sexual orientation, or age; focusing, but not limited to the disadvantaged.
- 2) To receive and administer funds for the benefit of the Corporation, or its successors, and to that end, to accept, receive, take and hold by bequest, devise, grant, gift, purchase, exchange, lease, transfer, judicial order or decree, or otherwise, for any of its objects or purposes any real or personal property, or both, of whatever kind, nature, or description and whenever situated, and subject to the restrictions and limitations hereafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or part of the income there from and the principal therefore exclusively for these purposes, either directly, or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law (herein collectively referred to as the "Internal Revenue Code";
- 3) To own, use, buy, sell, exchange, convey, mortgage, lease, transfer, invest, hold in trust, or otherwise dispose of, any such property, real or personal,

or both, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereafter set forth, and as otherwise permitted by law;

- 4) To borrow money, and from time to time, to make, accept, endorse, execute, and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, bills of exchange, and other obligations of the Corporation for moneys borrowed or in payment for property acquired or for any of the other purposes of the Corporation, and to secure payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed, indenture, agreement, or other instrument of trust, or by other lien upon, assignment of, or agreement in regard to all or any part of the property, rights or privileges of the Corporation whenever situation, whether now owned or hereafter acquired;
- 5) To operate exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, in the course of which operation:
 - a. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, trustees, officers, or other persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein;
 - b. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including publishing or distribution statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office except authorized under the Internal Revenue Code;
 - c. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
 - 6) To fulfill these purposes in a manner and in accordance with a policy that All Purpose Lifeskills shall not discriminate against participants on the basis of race, color, gender, sexual orientation, national origin or ethnicity;

7) To engage in any activity in which a nonprofit corporation may engage under the laws of the State Of Florida, and sections 170(b) and (e) and 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article IV

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board shall (3). In accordance with the Bylaws, the number of Directors may be increased to seventeen (17) but shall never be less than three (3). The Boards of Directors shall be elected according to the Bylaws.

Article VIII

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such a manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
