ARTICLE 1

The name or title by which said society shall be known in law shall be:

COMMUNITY OUTREACH**

ARTICLE 2

The location of the principle office of this corporation is 3340 volley drive in the city of Jacksonville, county of Duval and of the state of Florida, the name of the agent in charge thereof, upon whom process against this corporation may be served is: Jaclynn Christopher.

ARTICLE 3

The purpose of this organization is to establish a system and programs for training and educating the citizens of the community. Re-enforcement of values, morals and laws of the community, Providing and implementing programs that are essential and vital to the survival of the community. To educate, train, nurture, mentor and surgically remove hopelessness and despair, replacing with love, hope, power, purpose and destiny. This is essentially a "one-stop shopping" community based organization designed to be a lifeline to the community.

(3) An adult education and career development program, and opportunities for obtaining the GED will be available, as well as job training opportunities for youth and young adults (4) A teen Pregnancy Awareness Program will be available for teenagers, as well as training and educational programs for teenage mothers. (5) A Jail program will be developed to educate and prepare incarcerated individuals for re-entry into society. (6) Information and assistance will be available for the concerns of the elderly and establishing a Senior Adult Day Care. Family counseling, drug awareness, child abuse, abstinence education as well as an

educational information resource center will be developed. This organization will strictly prohibit discrimination in all of its programs and activities on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender, religion, age, disability, political beliefs, sexual orientation, marital or family status with any and all powers and acts that may be permitted by the officers and trustees of this corporation and the laws of the State of Florida.
