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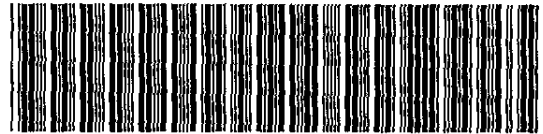

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

SECRETARY OF STATE

IN COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 617, F.S., (NOT FOR PROFIT)

The undersigned does hereby subscribe to, acknowledge and file the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of creating a corporation not for profit under chapter 617 of the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be: PALM BEACH COUNTY UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS WOMEN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE THREE

The principal objectives and purposes for which this corporation was formed are as follows:

A. To establish and maintain not for profit organization for the purposes of maintaining and increasing interest in the game of bowling, to fulfill obligations as a member association of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) and other action necessary or desirable in furtherance of the purpose of the corporation, all primarily for the benefit of the members.

B. To further promote the congenial atmosphere among the members of the corporation furthering their common interests and

objectives by permitted regular social contacts and commingling of the members.

C. To receive membership dues from members for the accomplishment of the above purposes if approved by the By-Laws of the Corporation in accordance with USBC rules.

D. To do everything necessary, proper or convenient for the accomplishment of the purposes set forth herein, and to do every other act which is not forbidden under the laws of the United States of America, the State of Florida (specifically Chapter 617) or by the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation.

E. The corporation intends that it qualify for exemption from federal income taxes under exemption granted to United States Bowling Congress (USBC), pursuant to Section 501, et seq., of the Internal Revenue Service Code as amended and regulations promulgated thereunder, and these Articles of Incorporation shall be construed consistently with the requirements thereof.

ARTICLE FOUR

Directors are elected by a majority vote of the delegates representing adult membership.

ARTICLE FIVE

ARTICLE SEVEN

In the event the corporation is dissolved within the State of Florida and ceases to exist for the stated purposes, such certificate of dissolution shall be filed with the Secretary of State according to the Florida Statutes for dissolving a non-profit corporation, and such assets as remain shall either be distributed to a corporation qualified for exemption from federal income tax under the same or similar exemption granted to the corporation, or shall revert to an escrow account for a period of three (3) years to allow time for reorganization and if reorganization is not accomplished in that length of time the assets shall then be distributed pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes and pursuant to Section 501, et seq., of the Internal Revenue Service Code as amended and regulations promulgated thereunder.

Having been named as registered agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity.
