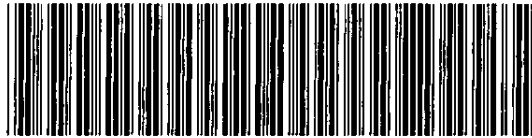

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

COLLEGE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM FOUNDATION, INC.

COLLEGE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM FOUNDATION, INC., a Florida non-for-profit corporation, pursuant to the provisions of section 607.1006, Florida Statutes, and under its corporate seal and the hands of its President and Secretary, MICHAEL MCMANMON adopts the following amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

The Board of Directors of said Corporation at a meeting called and held on NOV/27, 2007, with all officers and directors of the Corporation, adopted the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors, with agreement by the officers, deem it advisable and hereby declares it to be advisable that Articles II of the initial Articles of Incorporation be replaced in its entirety with the following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation:

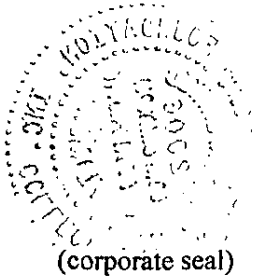
"ARTICLE II.-NATURE OF CORPORATION

The general nature of the business to be rendered by this corporation to help to provide for the needs of individuals who suffer from disabilities on the Autism Spectrum, or other related disabilities, which are not otherwise provided through families, insurance, or government programs. In order to promote its purpose, the Corporation may acquire property by grant, devise, or bequest and hold and dispose of such property as the Corporation shall require for the benefit of the members and purposes of the Corporation and not for pecuniary profit. This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code."

THERE ARE NO MEMBERS OF THE CORPORATION OR MEMBERS WHO ARE ENTITLED TO VOTE.
