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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ADVOCATES FOR SAFER COMMUNITIES, INC.

We, the undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person, competent to contract, hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file these Articles for the purpose of becoming a Corporation not for profit pursuant to Chapter 617.0202, Florida Statues.

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Advocates for Safer Communities, Inc.

ARTICLE II: PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business shall be in the County of Hillsborough, State of Florida as determined by the Board of Directors. The mailing address is: 5004 Beechcraft Way, Seffner, Florida 33584.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The lawful purpose for which this corporation not for profit is organized is as follows:

- 1. To establish better relationships and communication between youth and parents.
- 2. To create awareness through safety components that will help youth become more conscientious about the importance of safety.
- 3. To promote strategies/methods that will provide resources to aid law enforcement officials to solve murder cases of youth.

- 4. To educate parents on how to recognize the signs of a troubled youth and how to determine if their youth could be prey to criminals.
- 5. To provide information and resources/referrals to aid families who have experienced tragedies such as murder.
- 6. To develop strategies to assist in the decrease of criminal activities in communities that possesses a high crime ratio.
- 7. To provide support to grieving parents due to the loss of their child due to murder.

ARTICLE IV: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than five (5) individuals or not more than Eleven (11) members from the community.

The Board of Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the directors and each directors shall hold office for a term determined by the board of directors and until his or her successor is duly elected and qualified or until his or her death, resignation or removal from office.

Each person named in the Articles of Incorporation as a member of the Board of Directors shall hold office for a term of two (2) years and until his or her successor have been elected and qualified or until his or her death, resignation, or removal from office.

ARTICLE V: REGISTERED AGENT

The registered agent of this corporation shall be Darla Saunders, 5004 Beechcraft Way, Seffner, Florida 33584.

ARTICLE VI: TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation not for profit shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VII: OFFICERS

The officers of the corporation shall be the President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and other officers as provided by the By-Laws. The name of the office and the persons who are to serve as officers are as follows:

First Vice- President Kathanell Griffin

Second Vice-President Reverend Eli B. Chisom

Secretary Gloria Finch

Treasurer Conchita Canty-Jones

ARTICLE VIII: BASIS OF OPERATION

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of the purpose set

forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IX: DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE X: BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of this corporation shall be made by the Board of Directors and may be amended or rescinded as provided therein.

The latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order shall govern all proceedings of the corporation when not covered by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE XI: SUBSCRIBERS
