ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

(A Florida Not For Profit Corporation)

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation is THE GARDENS AT ADDISON CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC. The principal office address of the corporation shall be 104 La Costa Lane, Daytona Beach, Florida. For convenience, the corporation shall be referred to in this instrument as the "Association," these Articles of Incorporation as the "Articles" and the Bylaws of the Association as the "Bylaws."

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE
