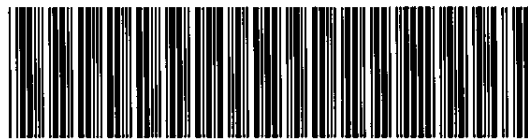

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

Article I: The name of the corporation which hereinafter is called the
CORPORATION is:

Article III: The specific purposes for which the CORPORATION is organized
are as follows:

- a. To establish a network of Agricultural Research Centers worldwide, in order to promote and demonstrate the scientific practices of bio-dynamic, French-intensive farming, including the technologies of organic gardening, hydroponics, integrated pest management, plant nutrition greenhouse construction and management, marketing and business management.
- b. To demonstrate current state-of-the-art organic farming and to provide concrete solutions for small and large scale farm systems. To provide research materials and on-site training and a basis for development and implementation of alternative agricultural technologies for Third World Countries.
- c. To create an ongoing educational outreach program, consisting of seminars in the communities and other such related programs as the Board of Directors may see fit.
- d. To facilitate and promote the purposes of the United Nations Association of the United States of America.
- e. To facilitate the implementation of the purposes of the United Nations as set forth in Agenda 21, Chapter 14, adopted by the Plenary in Rio de Janeiro, on June 14, 1992. To prepare and implement comprehensive policies and programs leading to the reclamation of degraded lands and the conservation of areas at risk, as well as

improve the general planning, management and utilization of land resources and preserve soil fertility for sustainable agricultural development. To provide incentives and, where appropriate and possible, resources for the participation of local communities in the planning, implementation and maintenance of their own conservation and reclamation programs. To develop and make available national and international know-how to farmers, extension agents, planners and policy makers on environmentally sound new and existing technologies and soil-fertility management strategies for application in promoting sustainable agriculture. To develop site-specific technologies at benchmark sites and farmers' fields that fit prevailing socio-economic and ecological conditions through research that involves the full collaboration of local populations. To develop suitable institutional mechanisms for policy formulation to monitor and guide the implementation of integrated plant nutrition programs through an interactive process involving farmers, research, extension services and other sectors of society.

- f. The herein described purposes are in no way intended to limit the CORPORATION in any of its lawful educational and social activities.

Article IV: The directors of the CORPORATION will be appointed by the President of the CORPORATION who shall act until their successors are duly chosen and elected at the first annual meeting of the CORPORATION'S Board. The term of directors will be determined at the first annual meeting and will subsequently be established by the by-laws of the CORPORATION.
