ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TURN IT AROUND, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of Turn It Around, Inc., under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is:

Turn It Around, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address of the initial principal office of the corporation is:

201 Ridge Road Tallahassee, Florida 32305

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The corporation is organized as a corporation not for profit, exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including but not limited to the following:

- (a) to establish, own, and operate any out patient or in patient treatment center, recovery home, convalescence center, adult and family congregate living facility and rehabilitation center, homes for unwed pregnant females and/or youth runaways, clothing and/or food distribution centers, living facilities, and shelters for homeless and economically disadvantaged persons and/or families, to include but not limited to those that are in crisis temporary or long-term;
- (b) to establish GED programs, literacy programs, after school programs for children, day care centers for the purpose of educating minors and/or adults in primary education, secondary education, trade education;
- (c) to provide substance abuse counseling, evidence-based interventions and techniques to provide a substance abuse outpatient center for offenders and exoffenders and high risk individuals who have high needs which would entail counseling, group therapy, behavioral management and rehabilitation;
- (d) to establish support groups to address anger; criminal activity; addiction; alcoholism; marital issues; mental illness; parenting; physical and sexual abuse; teenage pregnancy; mentorship for young, single mothers and teenagers;



- (e) to establish marriage education, counseling, mentors, and support groups for premarital couples and married couples;
- (f) to provide parenting classes, education, counseling, support, and resources for families in crisis.

Furthermore, the corporation may engage in other activities designed or intended to accomplish such purposes. To these ends, the corporation may do and engage in any and all lawful activities that may be incidental or reasonably necessary to any of these purposes, and it shall have and may exercise all other powers, and authority now or hereafter conferred upon corporations not for profit in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. MANNER OF ELECTION

The directors of the corporation will be elected or appointed as follows:

- a. **Initial Board.** Each person named in the Articles of Incorporation as a member of the initial Board of Directors will hold office until the organizational action of the Board of Directors or the first annual meeting of members and until such person's earlier resignation, removal from office, or death.
- b. Annual Election of Board. At the first annual meeting of members and at each annual meeting thereafter, the members will elect directors by plurality vote. Each director so elected will hold office until the next succeeding annual meeting and until such director's successor has been elected and qualified or until such director's earlier resignation, removal from office, or death.
- c. **Election of Chair of Board**. The Board may elect a Chair, and if one is elected, the Chair will preside at all meetings of the members and directors and will have such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL DIRECTORS AND/OR OFFICERS

The corporation has five (5) directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time, as provided in the bylaws, but will never be less than four (4). The names of the initial directors are:

ARTICLE VI. INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STREET ADDRESS

The corporation designates 201 Ridge Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32305, as the street address of the initial registered office of the corporation and names Talia Cotton as the corporation's initial registered agent at that address to accept service of process within this state.

ARTICLE VIII. EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of these Articles of Incorporation is June 29, 2006.

ARTICLE VIV. DISSOLUTION

In the event of liquidation, dissolution, or winding up, whether by voluntary act, bankruptcy or other judicial proceeding, all capital, surplus, property, assets and funds of the corporation remaining after paying all of its debts and obligations shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or shall be conveyed, transferred and paid over to such other not-for-profit corporation or corporations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Sections 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United State Internal Revenue law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, has executed these Articles of Incorporation on June 29, 2006.
