Article VIII
Compensation and Limitations

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall be inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, officers, or other private persons, except to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make payments and distributions in the furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the caring on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these article, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article IX
Dissolution of Assets
