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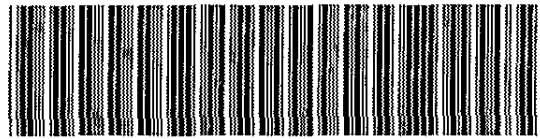

**CERTIFICATE OF REINCORPORATION**

Pursuant to s. 617.0901, Florida Statutes, this certificate of reincorporation was duly authorized by a meeting of its members regularly called or by a meeting of its board of directors if there were no members entitled to vote on the reincorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

STS. PETER AND PAUL RUSSIAN ORTHODOX GREEK CATHOLIC CHURCH OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized:

Satisfying religious needs of the Orthodox people by promoting, erecting and maintaining buildings for church rectory, religious schools and recreations by establishing auxiliary and associate bodies within its corporate body.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

*Directors are elected as stated in the Bylaws.*

IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE 11TH

IN RE:

APPLICATION OF THE STS. PETER AND PAUL RUSSIAN ORTHODOX  
GREEK CATHOLIC CHURCH OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, INC.

We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation, not for profit, under Chapter 617 Florida Statutes 1941, and pursuant to the following provisions of the proposed charter.

ARTICLE I:

The official name of the church corporation shall be STS. PETER AND PAUL RUSSIAN ORTHODOX GREEK CATHOLIC CHURCH OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, INC., with principal offices and activities located in and about the City of Miami, County of Dade, State of Florida.

ARTICLE II:

The official church seal shall be the impression of the official title of the church, the date shall be December 9, 1951, which is the date of its founding, and the Russian Orthodox Cross; the seal shall always remain in the custody of the incumbent pastor at the church rectory.

ARTICLE III:

The church services shall be conducted only according to the doctrines, rites, and ritual of the Russian Orthodox Church. The pastor is to be the spiritual head of the church.

ARTICLE IV:

The church corporation shall be under the ecclesiastical jurisdiction of the Supreme Church Hierarchy in North America, namely, the Most Reverend Leonty, Archbishop of New York and Metropolitan of America and Canada or his legal successors in office.

ARTICLE V:

The activities of the corporation shall be for the purpose of satisfying religious needs of the Orthodox people by promoting erecting and maintaining buildings for church, rectory, religious schools and recreations by establishing auxiliary and associate bodies within its corporate body.

ARTICLE VI:

The corporation shall have perpetual existence, and the assets of the corporation shall always remain the property of the religious body consistent with Article V above. In case of liquidation the incumbent Metropolitan shall see that the remaining assets are equally divided between St. Vladimir Seminary of New York and St. Tikhon Seminary in South Canaan, Pennsylvania.

ARTICLE VII:

The real estate and assets of the church corporation shall be in the name of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII:

Services in the church corporation shall be conducted only by a regularly ordained priest, one able to produce a certificate from a Theological Institution with a certificate of ordination and credentials and appointment by and under the authority of the Most Reverend Metropolitan Leonty, or successors in office.

ARTICLE IX:

All matters pertaining to the welfare, government, or progress of the church shall be determined by the parish council, who shall be elected by the majority vote of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors to be elected at annual meetings to be held in the month of January.

The temporary officers who shall conduct the business of this corporation and until the next duly authorized meeting for the election of officers shall be the following temporary officers:

- Rector, Very Rev. Cornelius J. Svigoon
- President, Daniel Matiuk
- Vice President, Charles Koban
- Secretary, Julia M. Cherevkoff
- Treasurer, Mary Manley
- Council Member, Stephan Pestey
- Council Member, Eugenia Doudnikoff
- Auditor, Helen Gheorghiev
- Auditor, Andrew Marchinsky

ARTICLE X:

All members of the Board of Directors are required to observe the Canonical Law of Communion and Confession and to take on oath before they are installed in office.

ARTICLE XI:

Any layman, baptized in the Russian Orthodox Greek Catholic faith, who recognizes and respects the Ecclesiastical Authority, and abides by the Church Canons and Charter and By Laws of this Corporation, may be a member of this Corporation, however, he or she must be 21 years of age before he or she can vote or hold office in this Corporation.

ARTICLE XII:

The By-Laws of the Corporation with amendments thereto shall meet local conditions and shall be the same and shall not conflict with the By-Laws or the Normal Statute for the Parishes of the North American Russian Orthodox Diocese as adopted at the Cleveland Sabor on December 30, 1935, and confirmed by Metropolitan Theophilus and any amendments adopted by future Sabors.

ARTICLE XIII:

All members of the church corporation are subject to this charter and By-Laws and such amendments as may be adopted.

ARTICLE XIV:

The highest amount of indebtedness for liability to which the Corporation shall subject itself, shall be ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND Dollars (\$150,000.00).

ARTICLE XV:

The amount of real estate which the Corporation may hold shall not exceed an assessing valuation of \$150,000.00.

ARTICLE XVI:

The Corporation shall have all powers, rights, and duties not inconsistent with the law of a Corporation, <sup>not</sup> for profit incorporated in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE XVII:

The articles of this Charter are not subject to change and only such Amendments may be adopted as are consistent with the foregoing paragraphs, and upon approval by a Circuit Court Judge.



IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the undersigned subscribed incorporators, have hereunto set our hands and seals, this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 1954, for the purpose of forming this Corporation, Not for Profit, under the laws of the State of Florida, and we hereby make and submit this charter and certify that the facts herein contained are true.

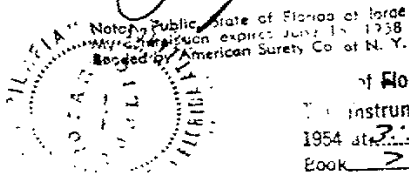
