AMENDED AND RESTATED

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NOKUSE EDUCATION, INC.

(A Corporation Not-Fer-Profit)

Pursuant to Section 617.1007 of the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Act, the Articles of Incorporation of Nokuse Education, Inc., originally filed with the Secretary of State on August 8, 2006, are hereby amended and restated in their entirety as follows.

The undersigned incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation hereby associates to form a corporation not-for-profit (the "Corporation") under the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Act and other laws of the State of Florida (Florida Statutes Chapter 617).

ARTICLE I

Name and Address The name of the Corporation is NOKUSE EDUCATION, INC. The principal office (and mailing address) is located at 11490 Emerald Coast Parkway, Suite 300, Miramar, 1849 Beach, Florida 32550. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office have the of the Corporation to any other address in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE II A comparish to the second of t

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are exclusively religious, charitable, and the scientific, literary or educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law (the "Revenue Laws"). In carrying out such purposes, this Corporation shall have all of the powers and authorities granted by statute and law, including the power and authority to accept gifts, devises and other contributions for charitable purposes, to hold and administer the funds and properties received and to expend, contribute and otherwise dispose of funds or properties for charitable purposes either directly or by contribution to other Section 501(c)(3) organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes; provided, however, said powers and authorities shall be exercised only in furtherance of charitable purposes.

ARTICLE III **Powers**

The Corporation shall have the power, either directly or indirectly, either alone or in conjunction or in cooperation with others, to do any and all lawful acts and things and to engage in any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, desirable, suitable or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering or attainment of any or all of the purposes for which the Corporation is organized, and to aid or assist other organizations whose activities are such as

Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Corporation shall exercise only such powers as are set forth in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and its regulations as the same now exist or as they may be hereafter amended from time to time.

ARTICLE IV Membership

The membership of this Corporation shall be limited to the members of the Board of Directors and such other persons as from time to time may become members as set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE V Term of Existence

The date when corporate existence shall commence shall be the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida and the Corporation shall have perpetual existence thereafter.

ARTICLE XII Limitations on Actions

All of the assets and earnings of the Corporation shall be used exclusively for the exempt purposes hereinabove set forth, including the payment of expenses incidental thereto. No part of the net earnings shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or any other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to

pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make distributions and payments in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the Corporation's activity shall be for the carrying on of a program of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or interfere with (including the publication or distribution of statements regarding) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Revenue Laws) or any organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Revenue Laws). The Corporation shall have no capital stock, pay no dividends, distribute no part of its net income or assets to any members, Directors or officers, and the private property of the subscribers, members, Directors and officers shall not be liable for the debts of the Corporation.

In particular, but without limitation of the generality of the foregoing paragraph, during such time as the Corporation may be considered a private foundation as defined in Section who were the particular 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provisions of any subsequent of the first terms of Revenue Laws) it shall not:
