

# GULF COUNTY GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY, INC.

( A Florida Nonprofit Corporation)

The undersigned, in order to form a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby sign and verify the following Articles of Incorporation.

# **ARTICLE I**

The name of the corporation is "GULF COUNTY GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY, INC."

### **ARTICLE II**

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

# **ARTICLE III**

The initial registered office of the corporation is 460 Redfish Street, Port St. Joe, Florida, 32456, and the initial registered agent at such address is Beverly Mount-Douds. The principal address of said corporation is the same.

## **ARTICLE IV**

## Section 1. Purpose.

1.1 The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is to operate for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as now stated, or as it may be hereafter amended. Purpose of said corporation will be the preservation of local genealogical and historical resources, to transcribe, abstract and record documents pertaining to the history of Gulf County. To act as an educator and researcher and to share information to the public, school district, private industries and government. In furtherance of its objective, the corporation may secure and distribute contributions from individuals, corporations, governmental entities and foundations.

### Section 2. <u>Limitations.</u>

- 2.1 The corporation shall have no capital stock, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any trustee, officers or members of the corporation, or any private individuals.
  - 2.2 The corporation shall have no members.
- 2.3 No trustee or officer of the corporation nor any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the corporation, or the winding up of its affairs. Upon such dissolution or winding up, all the remaining assets of the

corporation shall be distributed by the Board of Trustees for identical uses and purposes to any other organization which would then qualify for exemption under the provisions of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code as now stated, or as it may be hereafter amended.

- 2.4 No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation except as may be permitted under Section 501 (c) (3) by the Internal Revenue Code and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 2.5 Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code as now stated, or as it may be hereafter amended, or by organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of such code as now stated, or as it may be hereafter amended.

# Section 3. Powers.

3.1 In general, and subject to such limitations and conditions as are or may be prescribed by law, or in the corporation's Articles of Incorporation or By-Laws, the corporation shall have all powers which now or hereafter conferred by law upon a corporation organized for the purpose set forth above, or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred or conducive to the attainment of the purposes of the corporation.

## <u>ARTICLE V</u>

## Section 1. <u>Board of Trustees.</u>

1.1 The management of the corporation will be vested in a board of no less than three (3) trustees. The number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and powers and duties of the trustees shall be such as are prescribed by the By-Laws of the corporation.

# Section 2. <u>Initial Board of Trustees.</u>

2.1 The names and addresses of the trustees who will first manage the affairs of the corporation until the first annual meeting, as provided in the By-Laws, and until their successors are elected and qualified are:

# Section 3. <u>Limitation of Liability.</u>

3.1 A director shall not be personally liable to the corporation or its members, if any, of monetary damages for conduct as a director, except for acts or omissions that involve intentional misconduct, or a knowing violation of the law by the director, or for any transaction for which the director will personally receive a benefit in money, property or services to which the director is not legally entitled. If the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act is amended to authorize corporate action further eliminating or limiting the personal liability of directors, then the liability of directors of the corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the full extent permitted by the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, as so amended, without any requirement of further action by the directors or members. Any repeal or modification of this article shall not adversely affect any right or protection of any individual who was or is a director of the corporation at any time of such repeal or modification for or with respect to an act or omission of such director occurring prior to such repeal or modification.

### **ARTICLE VI**

The authority to make, alter, amend or repeal By-Laws is vested in the Board of Trustees and may be exercised at regular or special meeting of the Board.
