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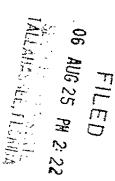

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

FREEDOM & LIFE GROUP, INTERNATIONAL, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of

ARTICLE I - CORPORATION NAME

The name of the corporation is Freedom & Life Group, International, Inc.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to Florida law.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The corporation's purpose is to be organized and to operate exclusively as a church, for the purpose of public worship, the preaching and teaching of the Word of God and the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the equipping of members for ministry, and the ordination of ministers of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV - CORPORATE OFFICE

ARTICLE V - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT & REGISTERED AGENT'S SIGNATURE

The name and the Florida street address of the Initial Registered Office and Agent of this Corporation is:

The method of elections of Officers shall be provided for in the Bylaws of the Corporation

ARTICLE VII - MEMBERSHIP

The qualifications, rights, privileges and duties of members of the corporation shall be stated in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII - SIGNER

The name and address of the person signing these Articles of Incorporation is as follows:

ARTICLE IX - STATEMENT OF POLICY

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE X – AMENDMENTS

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended by resolution of the corporation adopted by a majority vote of the general membership of the corporation present at a business meeting called for such purpose.

ARTICLE XI - DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
