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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ARC FOUNDATION, INC.

(a corporation not for profit)

FILED

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SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I Corporate Name

The name of this corporation is: ARC Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II Purposes

This is a corporation not-for-profit organized exclusively for public charitable purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code. More specifically, this not-for-profit corporation is organized to function as a supporting organization, within the meaning of Section 509(a)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, to support, promote, and advance the purposes of ASSOCIATION FOR RETARDED CITIZENS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, INC., a Florida corporation not-for-profit exempt from federal taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to-wit:

- A. To promote for all people with mental retardation and other developmental disabilities the opportunity to choose and realize their goals of where and how they learn, live, work and access leisure activities.
- B. To provide support and services in furtherance of the goal in paragraph A. above.
- C. To reduce the incidence, and limit the consequences, of mental retardation and other developmental disabilities through education, awareness, research, advocacy and the support of families, friends and community.
- D. To advise and aid families, to coordinate their resources and activities and to help the public develop a better understanding of the challenges of mental retardation.
- E. To solicit and receive funds needed to accomplish the above purposes.

ARTICLE III Duration

This corporation shall exist perpetually from and after the date on which these Articles are filed with the Department of State, unless sooner dissolved voluntarily or by law.

ARTICLE IV Management of Corporate Affairs

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. The number of Directors, and the method of their election, shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V Registered Agent and Office

The street address of the initial registered office is 3303 NW 83rd Street, Gainesville, Florida 32606-6227, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is Richard J. Bradley. This is also the principal office address.

ARTICLE VI Membership

The corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE VII Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be made by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Board of Directors at any meeting called for that purpose.

ARTICLE VIII Dedication of Assets

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes as set forth above, and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE IX Earnings and Activities of Corporation

- (a) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.
- (b) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation

shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future Federal Tax Code) or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future Federal Tax Code.)
- (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE X Distribution of Assets

In the event of dissolution or other termination of the corporation, title to all of its assets shall vest in ASSOCIATION FOR RETARDED CITIZENS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, INC., a Florida corporation not-for-profit exempt from federal taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or its successor, to be used exclusively for the purposes hereinabove set forth, it being intended that no distribution or payment shall be made which will impair or eliminate the tax exempt status of the corporation or which will result in the denial of tax exempt status to donations, contributions, or legacies received by this corporation to the extent that such tax exempt status shall be allowed under any applicable law or regulation. If ASSOCIATION FOR RETARDED CITIZENS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, INC. is not in existence, or is no longer qualified for tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, at the time the corporation's assets are to be distributed, the assets shall be distributed to another charitable organization exempt from federal taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code that serves similar charitable purposes to those served by this corporation, as selected by the corporation's Board of Directors or by a court of competent jurisdiction.
