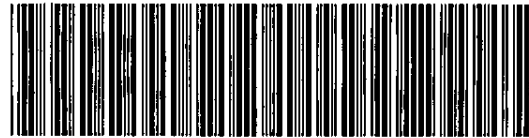

**AMENDMENT TO  
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
COMMUNITY TRAINING WORKS, INC.**

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and its Articles of Incorporation, the corporation, undersigned by its duly authorized representative, adopts the following Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation, as originally filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2006, under Document No. N06000010018.

- I. The name of the Corporation is COMMUNITY TRAINING WORKS, INC.
- II. The first amendment to the Articles of Incorporation is to affirm that the governance of the corporation by Members and Directors as set forth in the Articles of Incorporation is directed in the case that the corporation holds or intends to imminently hold real property as a community land trust, and in all other cases the governance of the corporation shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the corporation.
- III. The second amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation:

- A. Section 2 of Article III is hereby amended by altering it in its entirety so as to read:

“2. The specific and primary purposes are:

- A. To provide opportunities to unleash the intelligence and positive energy of low-income youth to rebuild their communities and their lives in Florida.
- B. To help economically disadvantaged, at-risk young adults become responsible, employable and productive citizens by providing them with opportunities to develop the vocational, educational and social skills needed to succeed
- C. To assist local communities with significant populations of residents who have low incomes, homeless, sex offenders and residents who are unemployed or under employed with leadership development, job readiness training programs, marketable skills training, on the job and try out training and job placement and mentoring and follow up services.
- D. To provide technical assistance to develop or enhance job readiness training program
- E. To place in employment youth, unemployed, youth exiting foster care, homeless, and sex offenders in employment in construction, trades, and other skill-based industries.

- F. To provide opportunities for very low, low and moderate income families to secure housing in ventures throughout the state of Florida but serviced through targeted operations in defined service areas, including through designations as community land trust, starting in the area of Northeast Florida which includes communities within Putnam, Duval, Clay, and St. Johns Counties of Florida, that is decent and affordable and that is controlled by the residents on a long-term basis.
- G. To preserve the quality and affordability of housing for future low and moderate-income residents of within the community.
- H. To combat community deterioration in economically disadvantaged neighborhoods by promoting the development, rehabilitation, and maintenance of decent housing in these neighborhoods; by promoting economic opportunities for very low, low and moderate income families of these neighborhoods; by making land available for projects and activities that improve the quality of life in these neighborhoods and by assisting residents of these neighborhoods in improving the safety and well-being of their community.
- I. To protect, the natural environment and to promote the ecologically sound use of land and natural resources and long-term health and safety of the community
- J. To discover and memorialize the history, culture, and architecture of the area to research, educate, discover, procure, purchase, restore, and assure the preservation of buildings, land, homes or other articles which may relate to the history, culture, and architecture of said community."

IV. The amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted with appropriate notice and vote of the Board of Directors or pursuant to written consent in lieu of a Meeting of all the Board of Directors duly considered and executed.

V. The above Amendment was adopted by all of the Members and Board of Directors on Aug. 28, 2014, to be When Filed, ~~2014~~.
