In accordance with Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, **B.A.Y. PROJECT**, **INC.**, a Florida not-for-profit Corporation, through its Board of Directors, hereby amends and restates, in their entirety, its Articles of Incorporation.

#### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is: **B.A.Y. PROJECT, INCORPORATED,** a Florida not-for-profit Corporation, (hereinafter the "Corporation").

#### ARTICLE II DURATION

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

## ARTICLE III PRINCIPAL OFFICE & MAILING ADDRESS

The place in this state where the principal place of business of the Corporation is to be located is 1116 East Eskimo Street, Tampa, Florida 33604.

#### ARTICLE IV REGISTERED AGENT AND ADDRESS

The name and address of the initial and current registered agent, who is a resident of Florida, is:

#### ARTICLE V PURPOSE

The purposes for which this Corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1. Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 2. Specifically, the Corporation is organized to conduct activities for the purposes of:
  - a) The advancement of education to teens between the ages of 13 and 18 years of age and teen moms between the ages of 13 and 21 years of age.
  - b) The enhancement of the intellectual, social, emotional, physical, vocational, spiritual development and technological skills of teens and teen moms.
  - c) The improvement of parenting skills and personal and vocational growth and development of parents who are 22 years of age and older.
- 3. Additionally, the Corporation shall engage in any other activities pursuant to the above purposes which have been determined or filed by the Internal Revenue Service to be permissible of an exempt organization under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law).

#### ARTICLE VI POWERS

The powers held by this Corporation are as follows:

- 1. Subject to limitations set forth in these Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws of this Corporation, this Corporation shall have any and all powers to do any and all things necessary or expedient pursuant to its purpose and to possess all rights, privileges, and immunities granted Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, subject to this limitation, namely, notwithstanding what may be expressed or implied from this charter this Corporation shall neither have nor exercise power nor shall it directly or indirectly engage in any activity that would 1) prevent it from obtaining Taxexemption described in paragraph 1 of Article V or 2) cause it to lose Tax-Exemption as an organization.
- 2. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article V hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the

Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

3. This Corporation may affiliate with other organizations and delegate its powers pursuant to its purposes subject to limitation of purposes and powers set forth in Article V and Article VI, Paragraphs 1 and 2.

## ARTICLE X SELECTION/ELECTION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Founders will be the Co-Chairpersons/Directors of the Board and will appoint nine (11) additional Directors for a total of thirteen (13) Directors. The number of board members may be raised or lowered by amendments of the By-Laws but shall in no case be less than (7). Replacements will be recommended to the Board of Directors by the one or both of the chairpersons and approved at a either a regularly scheduled board meeting or a special meeting called for that purpose wherein a quorum of two-thirds of the board members and Program Managers are present. Additional rules and regulations governing the Board of Directors are outlined in the Corporation's By-Laws.

#### ARTICLE XI SELECTION/ELECTION OF PROGRAM MANAGERS

Replacements for Program Managers may be recommended to the Board of Directors by any Director, current Program Manager, volunteer or other interested party and must be approved at a either a regularly scheduled board meeting or a special meeting called for that purpose wherein a quorum of two-thirds of the board members and Program Managers are present. Additional rules and regulations governing the Board of Directors are outlined in the Corporation's By-Laws.

## ARTICLE XII DEBT OBLIGATIONS AND PERSONAL LIABILITY

No member, officer or Director of this Corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this Corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers or Directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this Corporation.

## ARTICLE XIII DISSOLUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

#### ARTICLE XIV AMENDMENTS

There shall be no Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation or to the By-Laws that would (1) prevent this Corporation from obtaining Tax-Exemption as an organization or (2) cause this Corporation to lose tax-exemption as an organization.

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by any board member or program manager and must be adopted by a majority of the Board of Directors and Program Managers at either a regularly scheduled board meeting or a special meeting called for that purpose wherein a quorum of two-thirds of the board members and Program Managers are present. Procedures for amendments to the Articles on Incorporation are outlined in the Corporation's By-Laws.

## ARTICLE XV EFFECTIVE DATE AND METHOD OF ADOPTION

- 1. The effective date of the adoption of these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation was the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2008.
- 2. These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board of Directors and Program Managers of the Corporation at a meeting where a quorum was present on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 2008.
