ARTICLES OF Amendment

ARTICLE I

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

"Sunshine Kids Inc." was established specifically for the local central Polk county area persons with mental and physical disabilities to offer both a social and recreational setting on a consistent weekly basis, to promote an attitude of achievement in a friendly community based environment.

Description of Activities

Sunshine Kids Inc. is a small organization that formed as a bowling league for individuals with physical and mental disabilities. Presently that is all that we still are but, we are looking to expand to offer more activities in the future. Every Saturday our members meet at AMF Lakeland Lanes in Lakeland, FL for our bowling league at 12:15 pm for practice until 12:30 pm at which time we have all members take a seat and do our announcements and hand out awards from the previous week's bowling including; Bowler of the Week (2 awarded one from the boys and one from the girls), High series (an achievement awarded for bowling 50 pins or more over the members league average for a 3 game series), and Star awards (awarded for bowling 30 pins or more over the members average in a single game). After all awards and announcements have been completed members start league bowling which consists of 3 games.

Two times a year Sunshine Kids Inc. has a member's lunch/party at which time the organization purchases food, drinks, and utensils for all members and family members/ caregivers.

. We the Directors are working towards being able to give out yearend or season end awards such as; Trophies to the most improved bowlers, Plaques of achievement for season high series and game based on each individual members previous and current bowling scores, Consistency plaques for individual members who have held the most consistent average.

Sunshine Kids Inc. presents each member with Christmas gifts and we also present each member with a Birthday card (as close to if not on the actual birthday).

Proposed Future Activities

In the future we the directors of Sunshine Kids Inc. wish to be able to provide our members with exciting opportunities and experiences below are some of the proposed activities.

- Taking our members on a field trip to Sea World, The Florida Aquarium, Disney World, or Universal Studios. This will provide the majority of our members with an exciting experience they may never get to do otherwise or together with their fellow members.
 - Forming a Sunshine Kids team for the Special Olympics so that our members can
 participate in the games as a group and compete for a common goal while proudly
 displaying their team's colors, name, and logo.
- 3. Having an Arts and Crafts event where our members can create crafts to take home and also auction off at our craft sale which the proceeds will go towards field trips or events to come in the future.
 - 4. Taking our members to the beach.
- 5. Having an outside sports day playing various games and sports outside as well as having a lunch served.

ARTICLE III EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS

At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of Sunshine Kids Inc.:

1. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or others private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

- 2. No substantial part of the activities of Sunshine Kids Inc. shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, Sunshine Kids Inc. shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code

ARTICLE IV DURATION

The duration of Sunshine Kids Inc. shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The management of the affairs of Sunshine Kids Inc. shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in Sunshine Kids Inc. corporate bylaws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property or assets of Sunshine Kids Inc. under penalty of law.

There shall be no fewer than 3 directors on the Board of directors at any given time. The number of directors as of current is 5, their names, addresses, and titles are as follows:

ARTICLE VI PERSONAL LIABILITY

No member or director of Sunshine Kids Inc. shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of Sunshine Kids Inc. of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of Sunshine Kids Inc.

ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of Sunshine Kids Inc., assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not

'disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
