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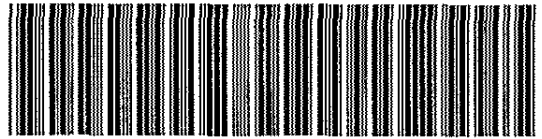

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BAYONET POINT YACHT CLUB INC.
A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a not-for-profit corporation, under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be:

Bayonet Point Yacht Club Inc.

ARTICLE III

Purpose:

The Bayonet Point Yacht Club Inc. (BPYC) is a non-profit, non-discriminating club open to all those age 21 and above who have motor or sailing boat interests.

The Club primarily serves the residents of Bayonet Point and its' surrounding communities, but has no formal territorial boundaries.

The primary purpose of the Bayonet Point Yacht Club is to promote the enjoyment of our Gulf waters through boating activities, establishing a medium for exchanging boating and fishing information, and the development of a positive community spirit among our neighbors and extended community

ARTICLE IV

Manner of Election:

Section 1. Nominations for officers and directors will be presented at the November membership meeting by the nominating committee which will consist of two members appointed by the Commodore. Nominations will also be accepted from the floor.

Section 2. Officers will be elected at the December monthly meeting by a majority vote of members present. In the event that there is more than one nomination for a specific position, the voting for that position will be done by secret ballot. The Commodore will appoint two members at large to count the ballots.

Section 3. The term of office will be one year, commencing on the first day of January.
