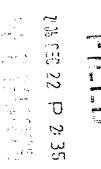

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FIRST EVANGELICAL BAPTIST CHURCH OF MOUNT SINAI, INC. (PREMIERE EGLISE EVANGELIQUE BAPTISTE DE MONT SINAI, INC.) A FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statues (Not for Profit), adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

FIRST EVANGELICAL BAPTIST CHURCH OF MOUNT SINAL INC. (PREMIERE EGLISE EVANGELIQUE BAPTISTE DE MONT SINAL INC.

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

Principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE (S)

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are): to solicit, collect, accumulate, administer, receive, and maintain real and personal property, or both, whatever form, including cash funds from public and private sources, and, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom, and the principle thereof, exclusively for religious, charitable, literary, scientific, or educational purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exemption organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

ARTICLE IV: MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

All directors must be members of <u>FIRST EVANGELICAL BAPTIST CHURCH OF</u> <u>MOUNT SINAI, INC.</u> (<u>PREMIERE EGLISE EVANGELIQUE BAPTISTE DE MONT SINAI, INC.</u>) Their election shall take place at a meeting called for that purpose, of which at least one week's public notice has been given. An affirmative vote of three fourths of those

members present will validate the choice. The directors shall be replaced or elected for a new term at the annual election of officers of the corporation.

ARTICLE V: LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302. Florida Statutes Unless limited as follows:

The corporation shall be empowered to enter into contacts, hold and convey title to real and personal property, and exercise all powers permitted a corporation not for profit and the other laws of the state of Florida not inconsistent with the general objectives enumerated herein. All funds of the corporation and any moneys from its operation shall be used in the furtherance of the purpose set forth hereinabove.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any director or officer of the corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for service rendered to or for the corporation in furtherance of one or more of its purpose(s), and no director or officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and the regulations issued pursuant thereto as the now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 107 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code and said regulations as they now exist or as may hereafter be amended.

ARTICLE VI: DISSOLUTION OF THE ORGANIZATION

Upon the dissolution of the Church, the Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the Church, dispose of all assets of the Church to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Trustees shall determine. Assets may be distributed only to Miami Baptist Association or other organizations, which agree with the Church's Statement of Faith.
