
ARTICLE I:

ARTICLE III:

The specific purpose(s) for which the Corporation is organized is (are):

- 1. Promote spiritual growth.
- 2. Promote personal growth and develop knowledge of thyself.
- 3. Promote a positive image of African-American women and anything that positively enhances the survival and well-being of African-American women.
- 4. Seek guidance from Elder African-American women.
- 5. Foster an environment amongst ourselves that is conducive to learning about the history, and the role African-American women have played and continue to play in developing this and other nations.
- 6. Develop local leadership to respond to community needs, particularly those of African-American women.
- 7. Provide moral and educational guidance to other young African-American women in the community.
- 8. Provide unity among People of Color.
