

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KIWANIS CLUB OF MANATEE EAST, INC. SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE. FLORIDA

The undersigned Incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation, natural person, competent to contract, does hereby form a not-for-corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Kiwanis Club of Manatee East, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The Principal office shall be c/o Ross Pfingsten, 9526 59th Ave. E., Bradenton, Florida 34202, and the mailing address shall be c/o Ross Pfingsten, P.O. Box 21015, Bradenton, Florida 34204.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

- 1. To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.
- To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships. 2.
- To promote the adoption and application of higher social, business, and 3. professional standards.
- To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive, and 4. serviceable citizenship.
- To provide through this club, a practical means to form enduring 5. friendships, to render altruistic service, and to build better communities.
- 6. To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism, and good will.
- For the purposes aforesaid, to take over the assets, rights and franchises of 7. the unincorporated club, known as the Kiwanis Club of Manatee East, Inc.,

and its members.

8. To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

ARTICLE IV. MEMBERSHIP

The members of the corporation shall be any persons, elected by the membership in accordance with the Bylaws. Members shall consist of five classes: Active, Reserve, Privileged, Senior and Honorary. Bylaws shall prescribe the rights and duties of each class of membership.

ARTICLE V. TERM

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IX. BYLAWS AND AMENDMENTS

The Bylaws are to be originally made and may thereafter be altered or rescinded, if in conformity with the Constitution and Bylaws of Kiwanis International, by a two-thirds vote of the active, privileged and senior members present at a meeting of the club, provided written notice of the proposed amendment shall have been given to the members at least two weeks prior to the meeting. There shall be no voting by proxy or absentee ballot.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES

Amendment to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed and adopted in the same manner as the Bylaws are amended, as recited in Article IX above.

ARTICLE XI. AFFILIATION WITH KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL

This organization hereby specifically acknowledges and agrees that it is affiliated with Kiwanis International and intends to continue such affiliation, and that it and its members will at all times recognize, abide by, and observe as effectively binding upon itself and its members the Constitution and Bylaws of Kiwanis International, now in force, or as hereafter amended, and that it will from time to time, upon request of Kiwanis International, amend its bylaws to conform to those of Kiwanis International, and further covenants and agrees whenever required, will dissolve or change its form of organization, and no amendments to the Articles of Incorporation or change in the purpose of the club will be made without the consent of Kiwanis International.

ARTICLE XII. INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STREET ADDRESS

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation shall be 9526 59th Ave. E., Bradenton, Florida 34202, and the initial registered agent at such address will be Ross Pfingsten.
