MARCO TO 3:35 Faith Foundations International, Inc.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the State of Florida, acting as Incorporators of a corporation under the Provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

I.

The name of the corporation is Faith Foundations International, Inc.

II.

The place in the state where the principal office of the corporation is to be is 1108 NE 9 St in the City of Ocala, County of Marion. The corporation may have such other offices, as may from time to time be designated by its Board of Directors.

III.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious and educational Purposes, including, for such purposes, the conducting of religious worship and the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

- 1. Preach and teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ for the furtherance of and the glory of the Kingdom of God.
- Fund and assist in any way the construction and operating of orphanages, residential Christian based schools, bible colleges and Christian based universities.
- Be a financial and materials distributor for the Kingdom of God including but not limited to missions work, missionaries, pastors, churches, church planting and the welfare of widows, orphans and strangers as defined in the word of God in the bible.
- 4. Be involved in any lawful activity authorized by the Word of God for the furtherance of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

IV.

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is three (3) and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are:

The officers of the corporation shall be chairman, secretary and treasurer and such other officers as may be provided in the By-Laws.

The officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the members of the corporation present at the annual business meeting of the corporation.

The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by the By-Laws, but shall be an odd number not less than 3 nor more than 13. The Board of directors shall be elected as set forth in the By-Laws.

V.

The directors and members of the ministry shall have the right to make and adopt such By-Laws as they shall deem proper and advisable and such By-Laws shall be made, altered, or rescinded upon a majority vote of the members.

VI.

The name of the initial registered agent of this corporation is Ray B. Nelson, whose address is 1108 NE 9 St, Ocala, Fl 34470, who signed these Articles of Incorporations to indicate his acceptance and agreement to act in this capacity as contemplated by Section 617.0503, Florida Statutes.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

VIII.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the

assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such a manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational or religious purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 (c) 3 of the internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

IX.

The corporation is a non profit corporation.

X.

The period of its duration is perpetual.

XI.

To further the above purpose, the corporation shall have full power to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire property, to publish a religious oriented newspaper or magazine, to own and/or operate a radio or television stations, support missionaries, raise funds, and to do those things necessary to promulgate the Gospel in an effective way and an efficient manner.
