### INCORPORATION

To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the state of Florida upon nonprofit corporations, including without limitation the generality of the foregoing, to acquire by donation, contribution, bequest, devise, gift, purchase, lease or otherwis any property of any sort or nature without limitation as to its lease or otherwise any property of any sort or nature without limitation as to its amount or value, and hold, invest, reinvest, manage, use, apply, employ, sell, expend, disburse, lease, mortgage, convey, option, donate, or otherwise dispose of such property and Income, principal and proceeds of such property, for any of the purposes set forth herein.

The idemnification and advancement of attorney fees and expenses for directors, officers, employees, and agents of the Corporation shall apply when such persons are serving at the Corporation"s request while a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or agent of another foreign or domesticCorporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, employee benifit plan or other enterprise, wheather or not for profit, as well as in their official capacity with the corporation. The Corporation may also pay for or inburse the reasonable attorney fee and expenses incurred by a director, officer, employee, or agent of the corporation who is a party of a proceeding in advance of final disposition of the proceeding, the Corporation also may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of an individual arrising from the individual"s status as adirector, officer, employee, or agent of the Corporation, wheather or not the corporation would have power to idemnify the individual against the same liability under the law. All references in these Articles of Incorporation are deemed to include any amendment or successor thereto, nothing contained in these Articles of incorporation shall limit or preclude the exercise of any right relating to idemnification or advance of attorney fees and expences to any person who is or was a director, officer, employee, or agent of the corposation or the ability of the corporation otherwise to idemnify or advance expense to any such person by contract or in any other manner. If any

word, clause, or sentence of the forgoing provisions regarding idemnification or advancement of the attorney fees or expences shall be held invalid as contrary to law or public policy, it shall be sever able and the provisions remaining shall not be otherwise affected. All references in these Articles of Incorporation to "director," "officer," "employee," and agent" shall include the heirs, executors, administrators and personal representatives of such persons.
