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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Life Lasting Impressions, Inc.

Article I

*The name and address of this principal corporation is **Life Lasting Impressions, Inc.**, located at 5247 Renoir Drive, Orlando, Florida 32818, in Orange County. The principal office is also the mailing address. The corporation is organized pursuant to the FLORIDA Nonprofit Corporation Code.*

Article II

This Corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. This corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law to: operate exclusively for charitable, and educational purposes. To aid the poor and disadvantaged Individuals and families toward a life of self-sufficiency. This program will consist of but shall not be limited to: Land Acquisition, Purchase/distribute educational supplies, to assist with educational resources, Training, Tutoring, Summer Camp, After School Care, Day Care, Elderly Help, Housing for displaced and homeless, provide food, clothing, shelter for needy, Music, Life Skills, Community Employment, Computer Labs, Seminars, Reading, English, Math, Banking, Finances & Investments, Health Fairs, Aids/HIV Education, Drug Awareness, and other programs to aid those in need.

Article III

As a means of accomplishing the above purposes and methods, the Corporation shall have the following powers:

- (a) To accept, acquire, receive, take and hold by bequest, devise, grant, gift, purchase, exchange, lease, mortgage, transfer, judicial order or decree, or otherwise, for any of its objects and purposes any property, both real and personal, of whatever kind, nature of description and wherever situated.*
- (b) To sell exchange, convey, mortgage, lease transfer or otherwise dispose of, any such property, both real and personal, as the objects and purposes of the corporation may require, subject to such limitations as may be prescribed by law.*
- (c) To borrow monies, and, from time-time, to make, accept, endorse, execute and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, monies borrowed or in payment for secure payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed, indenture, agreement, or other instrument o trust, or by other lien upon assignment of, or agreement in regard to all or any part of the assignment of, or agreement in regard to all or any part of the property, rights, or privileges of the corporation wherever situated, whether now owned or hereafter to be acquired.*
- (d) To invest and reinvest its funds in such stock, common or preferred, bonds, debentures, mortgages, or in such other securities and property real and*

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
personal, as it shall deem advisable, subject to the limitations and conditions contained in any bequest, devise, grant, or gift, provided such limitations and conditions are not conflict with the provisions of 501© (3) of the internal revenue of 1986 an applicable regulations thereunder, as they now exist or as they may be amended.

Article IV

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual, no stock and shall have no members.

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Article VI

(a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for Educational and Charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to carry on (1) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 c 3 of the Internal Revenue code. or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article VII

Article VII



Any such asset not disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is located, exclusive for such purposes or to such organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
