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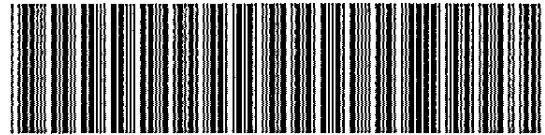

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
Life Point Church, Inc.
A Florida "Not for Profit" Corporation**

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under Chapter 17 of Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

NAME OF CORPORATION:

The name of the corporation is Life Point Church, Inc.

PRINCIPAL OFFICE:

The principal office of the corporation is located in the city of Pace and the county of Santa Rosa.

MAILING ADDRESS:

The mailing address of the corporation is:

Pace, FL 32571

REGISTERED AGENT:

The name of the registered agent of the corporation is Henry Judy. The address of this registered agent is 5902 Jameson Circle, Pace, FL 32571.

DURATION/MEMBERSHIP:

The period of duration is perpetual. The qualification for members, if any, and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the bylaws.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

The method of selection of the Board of Directors and number of directors shall be stated in the bylaws.

CORPORATE PURPOSES

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are exclusively charitable and consist of the following:

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

Life Point Church, Inc. will be providing the following services:

- a) To spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the worship of God among its attendants and practice the Christian virtues inculcated in the Holy Scriptures by any and all means possible
- b) To ordain, employ and discharge ordained ministers of the Gospel and others, to conduct and carry on divine services at the place of worship of the corporations, and elsewhere, and to collect and disburse any and all necessary funds for the maintenance of Life Point Church, Inc. and the accomplishment of its purpose within the state of Florida and elsewhere.
- c) To handle affairs pertaining to property and other temporal matters as required by the civil authorities.
- d) To educate the body of Christ through any and all educational means deemed appropriate.

501(c)(3) LIMITATIONS

Article 1

CORPORATE PURPOSES: Notwithstanding any other provision of these 7 articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal and state income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Article 2

EXCLUSIVITY: This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that also qualify as Section 501(c)(3) exempt organizations.

Article 3

NO PRIVATE INUREMENT: The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. The Corporation shall not distribute any gains, profits or dividends to the Directors, Officers, or Members thereof, or to any individual, except as reasonable compensation for services actually performed in carrying out the Corporation's

charitable and educational purposes. The property, assets, profits and net income of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes no part of which shall inure to the benefit of any individual.

Article 4

LOBBYING AND POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Article 5

DISSOLUTION: Upon winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. If the Corporation holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the Circuit Court of the district in which the Corporation's principal office is located, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.


INDEMNIFICATION

Any person (and the heirs, executors and administrators of such person) made or threatened to be made a party to any action, suit or proceeding by reason of the fact that he is or was a Director or Officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against any and all liability and the reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees and disbursements, incurred by him (or by his heirs, executors or administrators) in connection with the defense or settlement of such action, suit or proceeding, or in connection with any appearance therein, except in relation to matters as to which it shall be adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding that such Director or Officer is liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of his duties. Such right of indemnification shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which such Director or Officer (or such heirs, executors or administrators) may be entitled apart from this Article.


