The undersigned incorporated to these Articles of Incorporation, being competent to contract, hereby states the desire to form a corporation not-for-profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MARCO ISLAND FIRE-RESCUE FOUNDATION, INC.

We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a corporation not-for-profit under Chapter 617, laws the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liability, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation not-for-profit.

ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is MARCO ISLAND FIRE-RESCUE FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The purpose for which MARCO ISLAND FIRE-RESCUE FOUNDATION, INC. is organized is exclusively for not-for-profit purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law to wit support of fire and rescue personnel and services. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be use in the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation,

and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE III TERM OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the corporation shall date from the approval of this Charter by the Secretary of State of Florida, and shall continue in perpetuity. If for any reason the corporation shall cease to exist s a legal entity, and its charter shall expire or be terminated, the property both real and personal owned by the corporation shall be sold and all proceeds shall be donated to one or more non-profit charitable organizations under the laws of the State of Florida which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections or any prior or future law, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP

Any person or persons interested in the support of fire and rescue personnel and services.

ARTICLE V ADDRESS

The initial address of the principal office of this corporation is 1104 N. Collier Blvd., Marco Island, Florida 34145. The Board of Directors may, from time to time, move the principal office to any other address in Florida.

ARTICLE VI SUBSCRIBERS

ARTICLE VII OFFICERS

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a President, Treasurer and Secretary. Each of said officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors for one year and all terms of office shall be for one year. The past President shall serve as an ex-officio member of the Board of Directors.
