The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a not for profit corporation, compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, hereby state:

### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is: Regions' Associates For Good Government-CCE, Inc.

### ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The initial street address of the principal office of the corporation is: 1900 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, Birmingham, AL 35203. The corporation may from time to time move its principal office to another location.

### ARTICLE III - PURPOSES

The purposes of the corporation are to:
