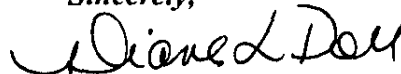

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
REGIONS' ASSOCIATES FOR GOOD GOVERNMENT-CCE, INC**

A FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a not for profit corporation, compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, hereby state:

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the corporation is: Regions' Associates For Good Government-CCE, Inc.

ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

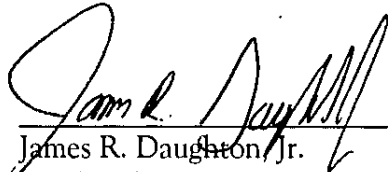
ARTICLE IX – CONFLICT OF INTERESTS

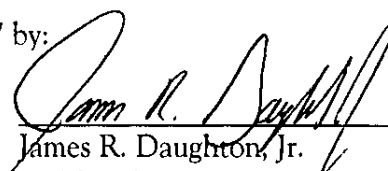
ARTICLE X – DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS
