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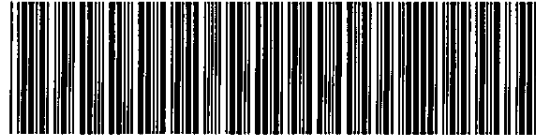

FLORIDA NONPROFIT ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE LILLIAN AND ALBERT NOREN FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE I

NAME

THE LILLIAN AND ALBERT NOREN FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

1. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

2. To provide scholarships and other aid to deserving young persons interested in the advancement of dance and music in the greater Philadelphia area and for such other charitable purposes as are permitted by the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

PROVISIONS REGARDING ACTIVITIES, EARNINGS AND DISSOLUTION

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in

(including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IV

TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of receipt of these Articles of Incorporation by the Secretary of State of Florida.

ARTICLE V

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial principal office of this corporation is 54 SW BOCA RATON BOULEVARD, BOCA RATON, FLORIDA 33432. The initial registered agent of this corporation is MICHAEL I. post office address of the corporation as well as the location of its principal office.

ARTICLE VI



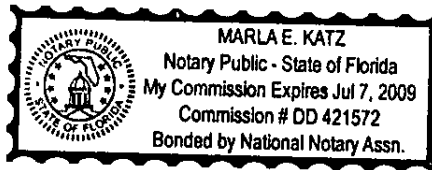
