ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JUNKANOO SCHOLARSHIP FUND, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, with other persons, being desirous of forming a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, agrees to the following: ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is JUNKANOO SCHOLARSHIP FUND, INC.

ARTICLE II - NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERS

The corporation shall not have a class of membership.

ARTICLE IV - TERM OF EXISTANCE

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

Section 1. The officers of the corporation shall be a President, Vice-President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer.

ARTICLE VIII - BY-LAWS

Section 1. The Board of Directors of this corporation may provide such by-laws for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purposes as they may deem necessary from time to time.

<u>ARTICLE XI - INDEBTEDNESS</u>

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may at any time subject itself shall never be greater than 80% of the value of the property of the corporation.

ARTICLE XII – ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY

In order to promote the purposes of this corporation, it may acquire property by grant, gift, purchase, devise, or bequest, and hold and dispose of such property as the corporation shall require in a manner not for pecuniary profit, and not inconsistent for a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue or corresponding section(s) of any future Federal Tax Code.

ARTICLE XIII – ANNUAL MEETING

Section 1. At minimum a meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held annually for the election of officers and members of the Board of Directors and for other business before the Board.

Section 2. The corporation may provide in its by-laws for the holding of additional regular meetings and any special meetings, and shall provide notice of all such meetings.

Section 3. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the holding of any meetings.

ARTICLE XIV - DISTRIBUTION OF EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions set forth in Article Two hereof. Unless the bylaws provide otherwise, the Board of Directors may fix the compensation of directors. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

ARTICLE XV - DISSOLUTION

Upon the winding up and dissolution of the corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
