Articles of Incorporation

of

Bhaktivedanta Book Trust Special Projects Inc

I.

The name of the corporation is Bhaktivedanta Book Trust Special Projects FnC.

II.

The principal place of business is 15411 NW 89 Street, Alachua, FL 32615.

III.

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit religious corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Religious Corporation Law for religious and charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are:
- (a) To establish and maintain an association of persons interested in assisting and supporting the Bhaktivedanta Book Trust, a California trust, and the Bhaktivedanta Book Trust International, Inc., a California non-profit corporation, in their various endeavors. These include, but are not limited to,
 - (1) supporting the publishing and distribution of the religious books of His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada, founder-acharya of the International Society for Krishna Consciousness, and literature in the line of his tradition and teachings, through research and development and execution of marketing, editorial and volunteer management, and any work supporting that effort

- (2) supporting the publishing and distribution of religious content in the tradition and teachings of A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami in all media forms
- (b) To encourage, accept, invest, safeguard, and distribute charitable funds contributed for the purposes describe in Sub Section (a) above.
- (c) To elicit volunteer efforts to achieve the purposes described in Sub Section (a) above.
- (d) To foster among the general public a wider recognition of the literary contributions of His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada.
- C. In furtherance of these purposes, the Corporation, as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine, may receive property by gift, device or bequest; may invest or reinvest such property; and may apply the income and principal thereof, either directly or through contributions to any organization or organizations existing exclusively for religious or charitable purposes.
- D. The Corporation may also engage in any act or activity lawful for corporations organized under the Florida Nonprofit Religious Corporation Law, provided that such act or activity is performed in accordance with the above purposes.

IV.

The Directors of the corporation will be voted on annually by the officers of the corporation as stated in the bylaws.

The officers of this corporation are

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended.
- B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
- C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

VI.

VII.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious and charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to or for the Corporation and to make payments and distributions in

furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Two hereof.

On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to the Bhaktivedanta Book Trust, a California non profit organization qualified as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended. In no event shall any of such assets or property be distributed to any director or officer, or any private individual.
