ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF LAKEWOOD ESTATES HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. (A Florida Non-Profit Corporation)

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is LAKEWOOD ESTATES HOMEOWNÉ ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide for maintenance and preservation of water retention areas and stormwater swales within that certain tract of property described as:

ALL THAT REAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF

and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents within the above described property and any additions thereto as may hereafter be brought within the jurisdiction of this corporation for this purpose to:

a) Exercise all of the powers and privileges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the corporation as set forth in that certain Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, hereinafter called the "Declaration", applicable to the property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and recorded or to be recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Orange County, Florida, and as the same may be amended from time to time as therein provided, said Declaration being incorporated herein as set forth at length;

- b) Fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the corporation, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the corporation;
- c) Acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the corporation;
- d) Dedicate, sell or transfer all or any part of the Common Area to any public agency, authority, or utility for such purposes and subject to such conditions as may be agreed to by the members. No such dedication or transfer shall be effective unless an instrument has been signed by two-thirds (2/3) of the members, agreeing to such dedication, sale or transfer;
- e) The corporation shall operate, maintain and manage the surface water or stormwater management system(s) in a manner consistent with the St. Johns River Water Management District Permit No. 40-095-105339-1 requirements and applicable District rules, and shall assist in the enforcement of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions which relate to the surface water or stormwater management system;

- f) The corporation shall levy and collect adequate assessments against members of the corporation for the costs of maintenance and operation of the surface water or storm water management system; and
- g) have and to exercise any and all powers, rights, and privileges which a corporation may now or hereafter have or exercise under the laws of the State of Florida governing corporations not for profit.

ARTICLE III

The term of existence of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

There shall be three (3) members of the initial Board of Directors of the corporation. The names and address of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first election thereof are as follows:

Thereafter, the Board of Directors shall be elected by a majority of the members pursuant to the by-laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V

The affairs of the corporation are to be managed by a President, Secretary and Treasurer. Such officers will be elected annually pursuant to the by-laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VI

- a) This corporation shall have no capital stock and shall be composed of members rather than stockholders. The membership of the corporation shall consist of owners of a fee interest in any lot included in the lots of Lakewood Estates Subdivision, Orange County, Florida. Each member shall be entitled to one vote for each lot owned.
- b) Upon transfer of title to a member's interest in the aforedescribed property by death, sale or otherwise, the transferor shall be terminated as a member and the transferee shall be eligible for membership pursuant to the foregoing provisions of this article.
- c) There shall at no time be more than one voting member for each lot included in the lots of Lakewood Estates Subdivision, Orange County, Florida.

ARTICLE VII

The bylaws of the corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded by the voting members of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

These Article of Incorporation may be amended by the act of the voting members of the corporation. Such amendments may be proposed and adopted in the manner provided in the by-laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX

This corporation shall be dissolved and its affairs wound up by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the corporation's voting members or when the object for which the corporation is organized has been fully accomplished.

In the event of termination, dissolution or final liquidation of the corporation, the responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the surface water or stormwater management system must be transferred to and accepted by an entity which would comply with Section 40c-42.027, F.A.C., and be approved by the St. Johns River Water Management District prior to such termination, dissolution or liquidation.

ARTICLE X

The address of this corporation's initial registered office in the State of Florida is 235 E. Fifth St., Apopka, FL 32703. The name of the initial registered agent at the above address is H. Lewis Kellom.

ARTICLE XI

The name and residence address of the subscriber of these Articles of Incorporation is H. Lewis Kellom, 235 E. Fifth St., Apopka, FL 32703.

ARTICLE XII

Existence of the corporation shall commence with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State, Tallahassee, Florida.
