ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OCT 12 AM 11: 17

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

The following Articles are amended/added to the corporation of Juneteenth of St. Petersburg, Inc. The date of the amendment, voted by the members, was September 25th, 2006. The number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

To coordinate the celebration of Juneteenth in the city of St Petersburg, FL. Juneteenth is the oldest nationally celebrated commemoration of the ending of slavery in the United States.

The organization is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION

The manner in which the corporation will be dissolved:
